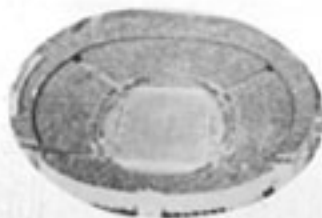

ROYAL STREET IN THE VIEUX CARRE, NEW ORLEANS—In the early days Rue Royale was the main street of the French city. Under its overhanging balconies fashionable New Orleans strilled a century ago. Today it is a street of curio dealers, perfume shops and antique shops, where one can find old jewelry, chinaware and firearms. Lining Royal Street are such famous landmarks as the Sazerac Coffee House at 104; at 121 the site of the office and home of Dr. Francisco Anthonio, Napoleon's physician; 126 Merchants Exchange; 127 The Gem where the Mistick Krewe of Comus was organized January 10, 1857, giving New Orleans its first night street parade during Mardi Gras.
