1907**

(Note the label for the record calls the church, the Chaneyville Church.)

This is the earliest record found that uses the name Chaneyville, even though since the 1880s the church had been located on the Carney place. The name "Chaneyville" reflects the history of the school, in that the original school was located on the land of James Johnson Bailey Chaney.

All of the men who acted as trustees for the church and the school were at this time tenants, with exception of George Lea Sanford.

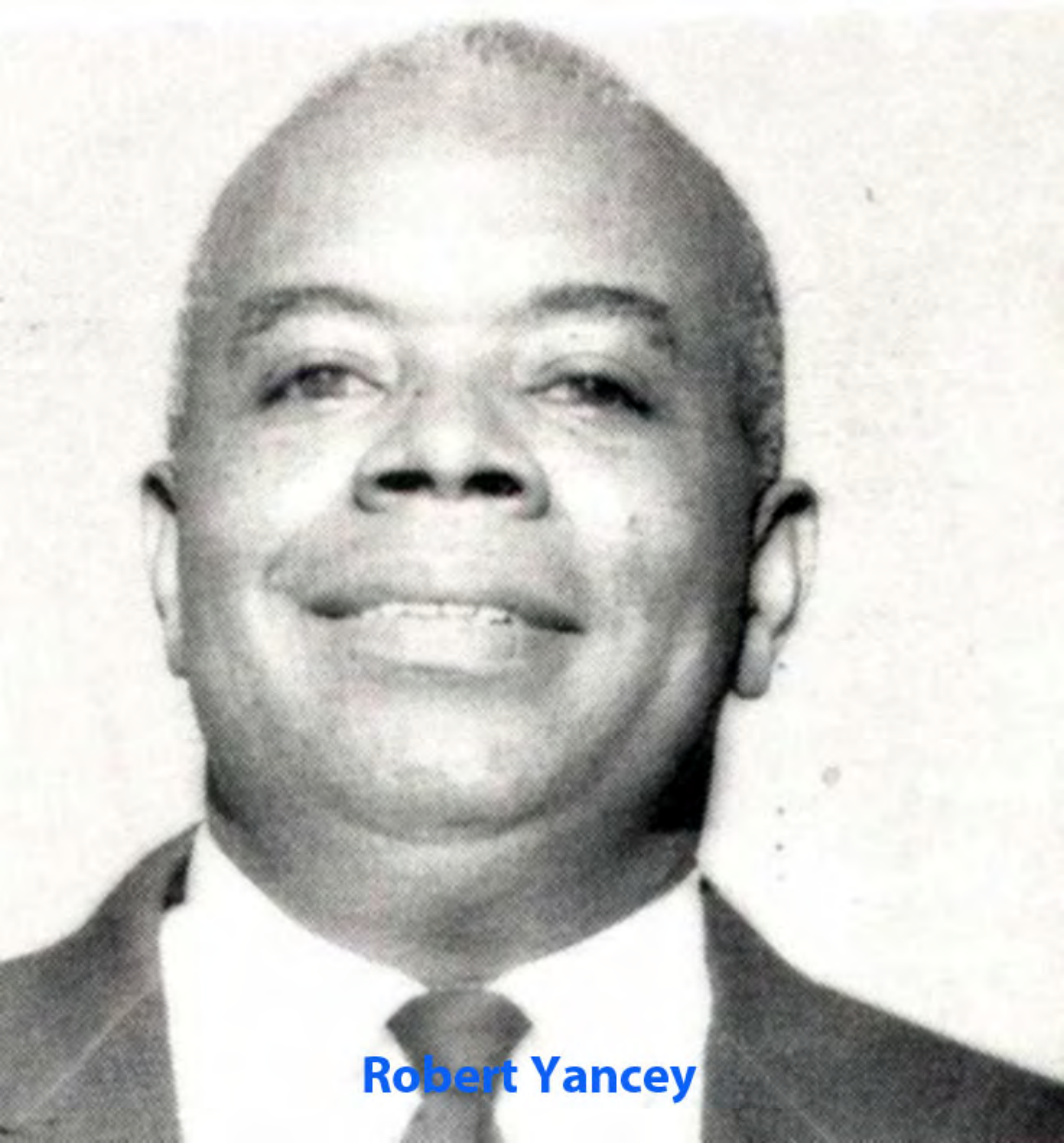

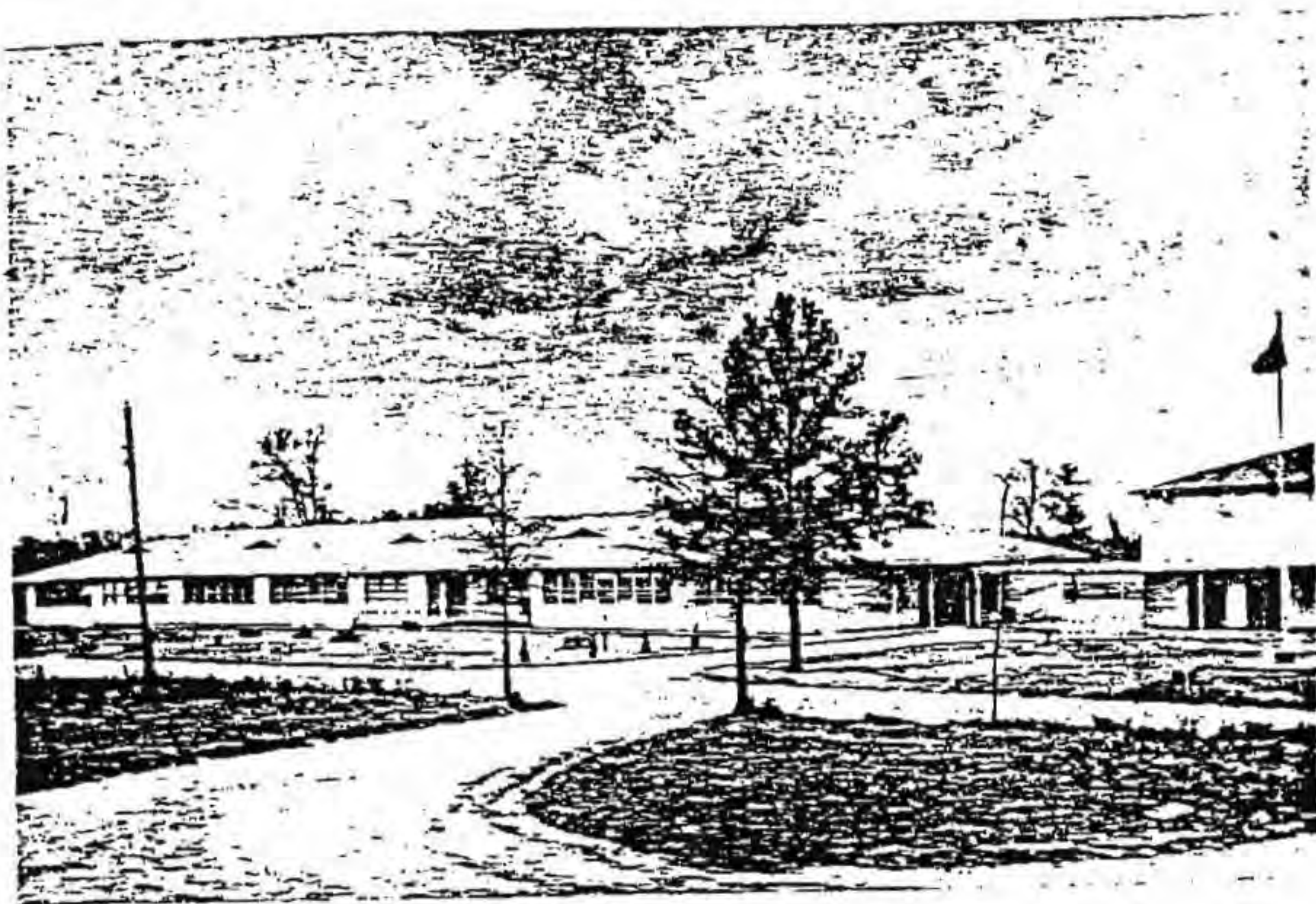

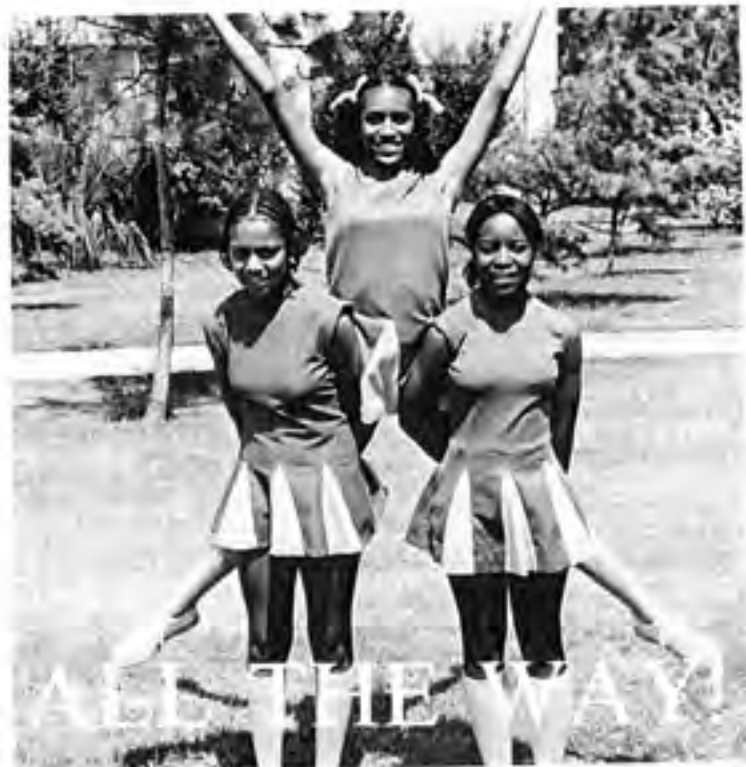
