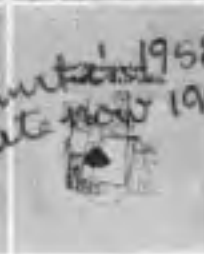

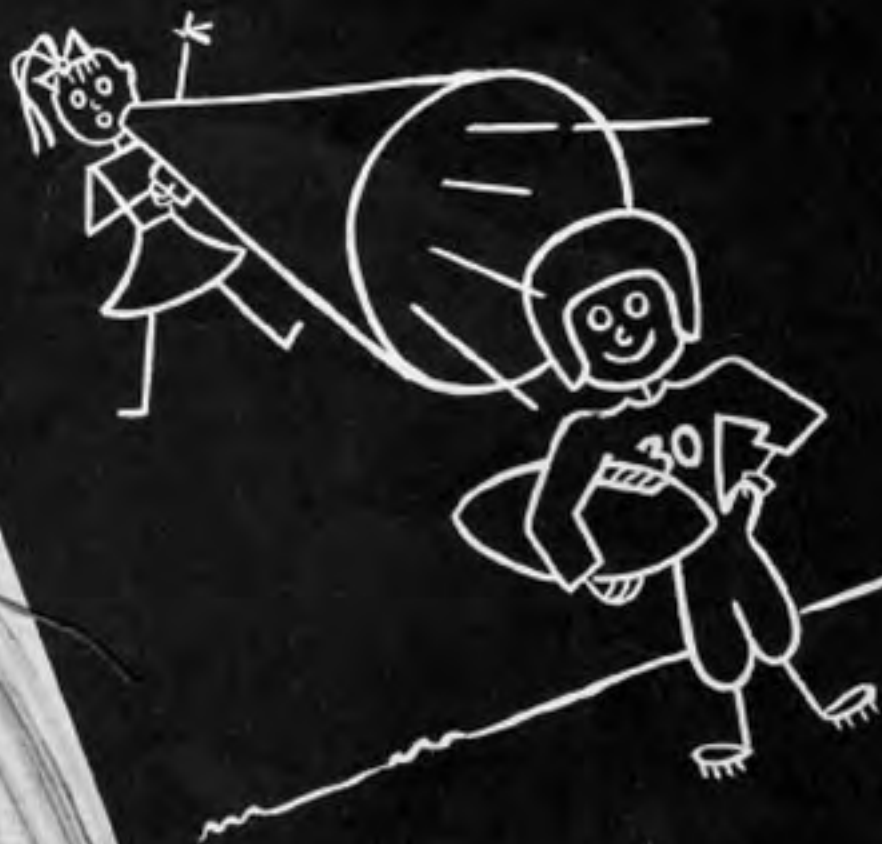

1917 - 1951

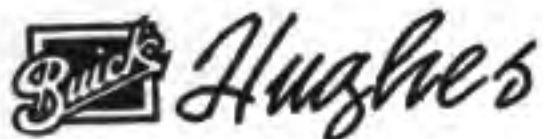
