Mrs. Peterson was born in Jennings, Louisiana, where, at the time of her death, she was a teacher of Language Arts, High School Physical Education and Basketball Coach as well.

Mrs. Peterson received her B.S. degree from Southern University. Prior to coming to Jefferson Davis High School she was employed at Katie B. Thomas School in Elton, Louisiana.

Beloved by her students, she served prodigiously in the church, school and community. She was a conscientious member and worker of Mt. Triumph Baptist Church where she worked in the field of religion diligently. She played active roles in key positions in Mt. Triumph such as being a member of the first Junior Church department, and receiving extensive training in the field of Christian Education, which involved Youth Encampments.

In addition, she served as a Sunday School teacher, Bible instructor in the Young Matrons Organization, a member of several choirs and sponsor of the Annual Religious Education Program in the church.

The short span of years that she lived coupled with the many kind acts that she rendered won for her the title "a short but very useful life." She was loved and admired by many because of her reflective life of service.

She held membership in the Louisiana Education Association, The Jefferson Davis Teachers Association, the American Legion Women Auxilliary and numerous other organizations.

A lover of human nature, she left an indelible mark on the lives of all with whom she came in contact.

In view of the facts presented, the staff and student body unanimously agreed to dedicate the first "Hawk" to our dearly beloved Mrs. Josephine Peterson.

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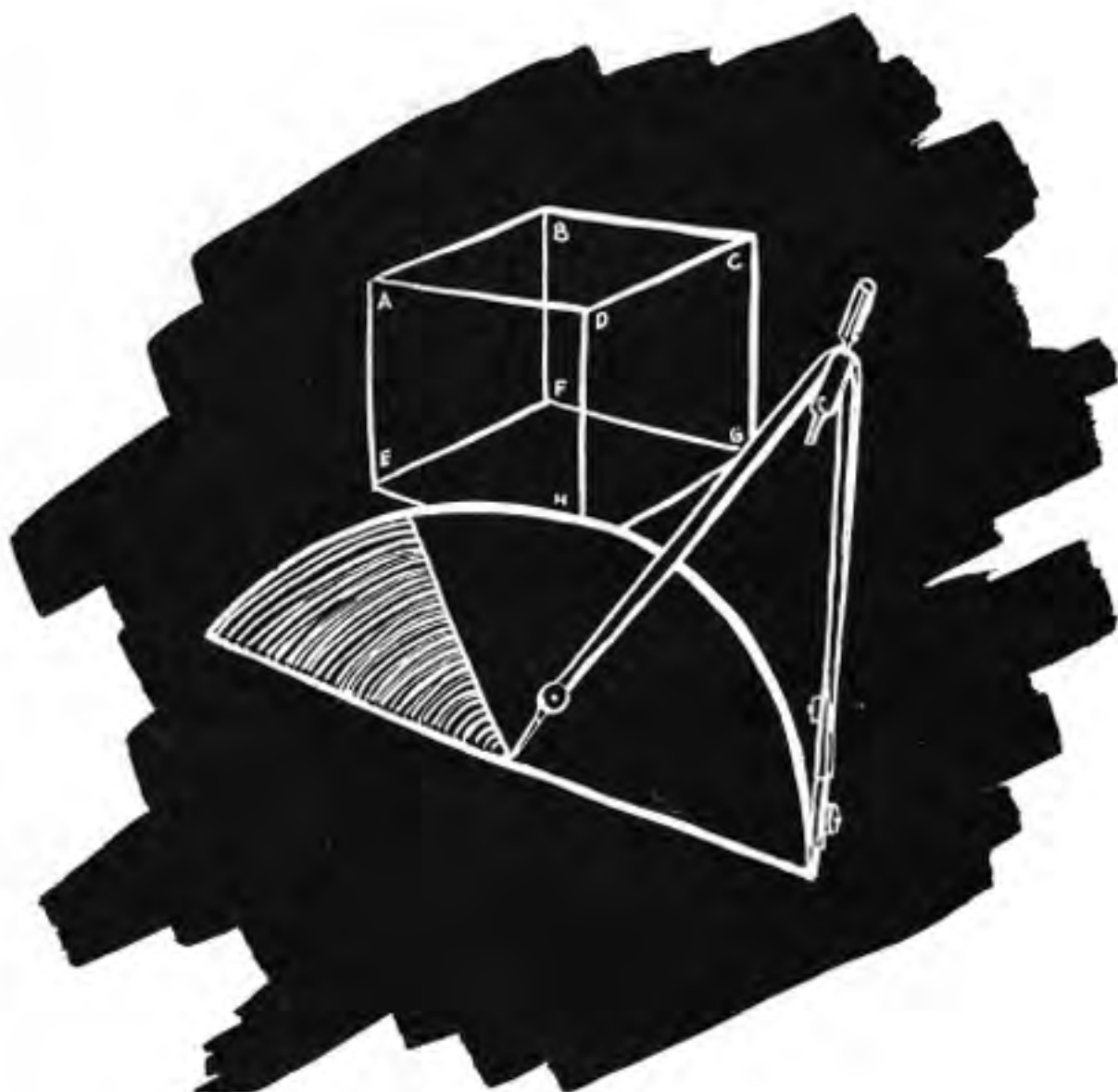


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
