The Principal's Message

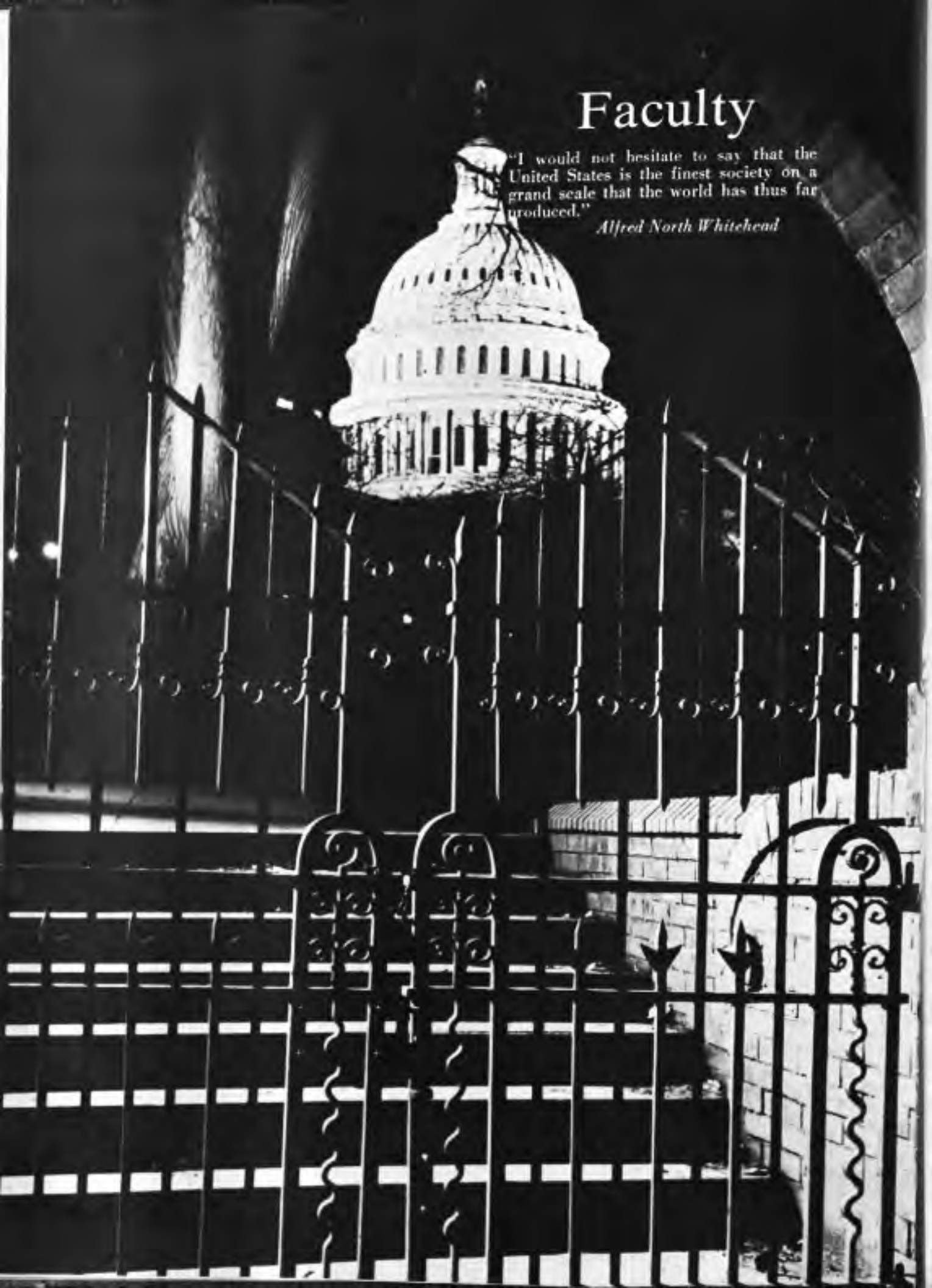
