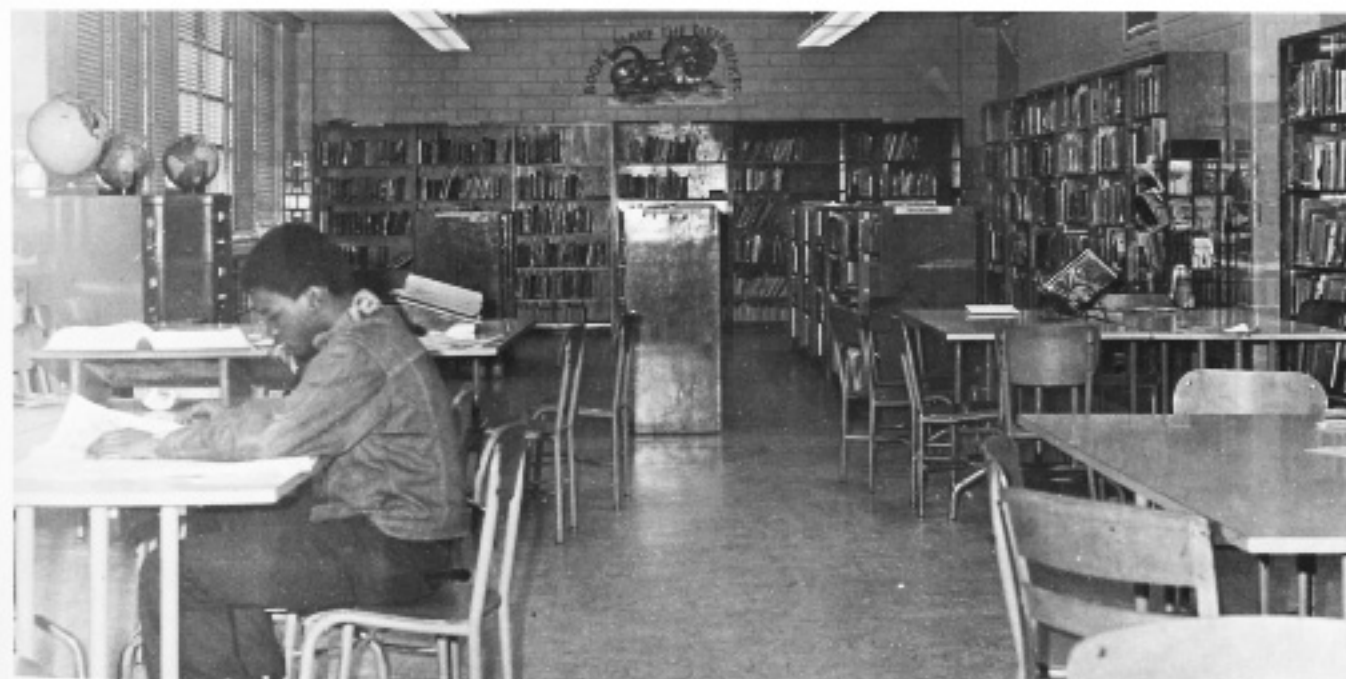


Growing . . .

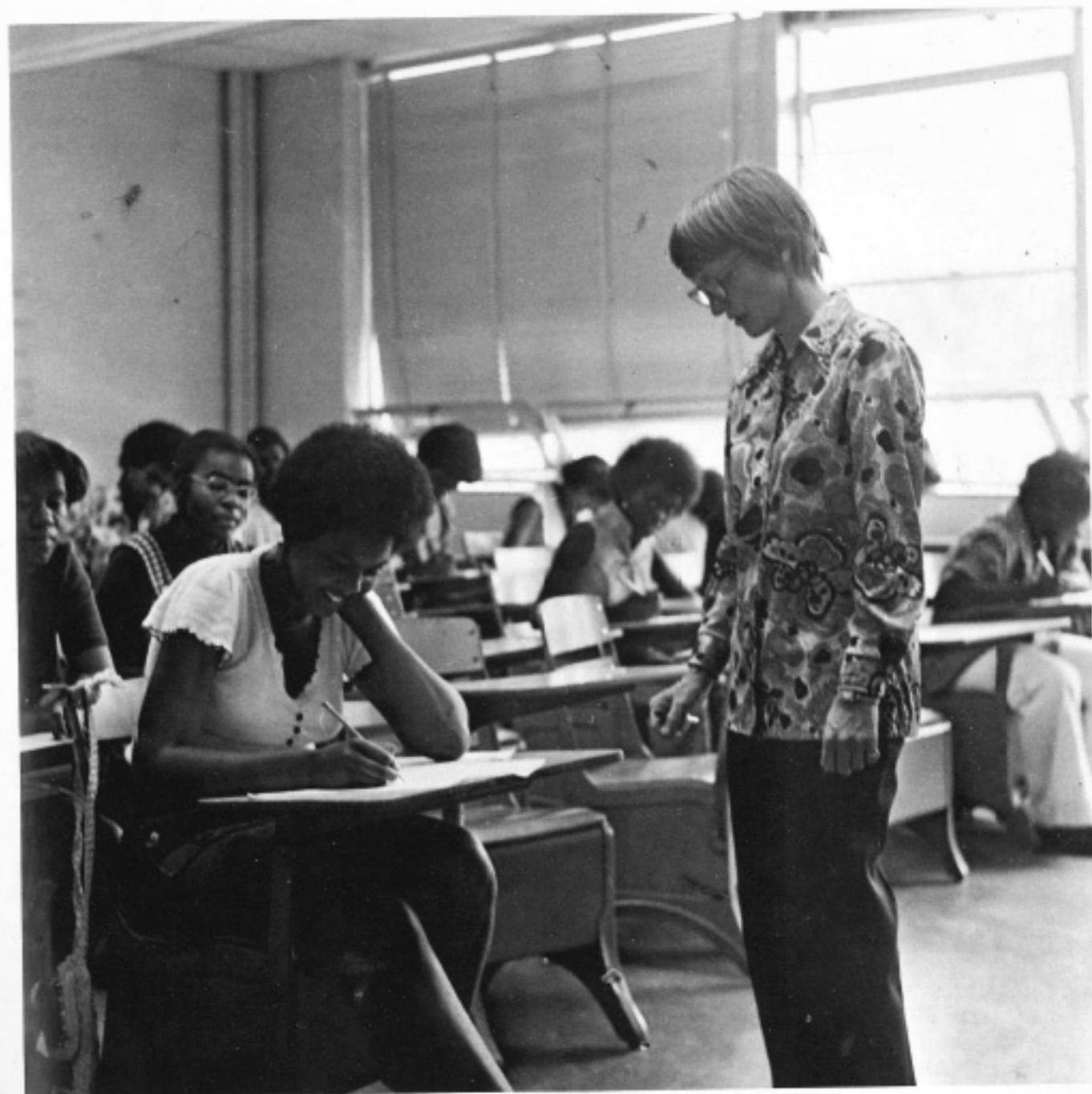
This book, the first such volume in several years at Richwood, is an attempt to show that Richwood is growing and that "we can make it happen."



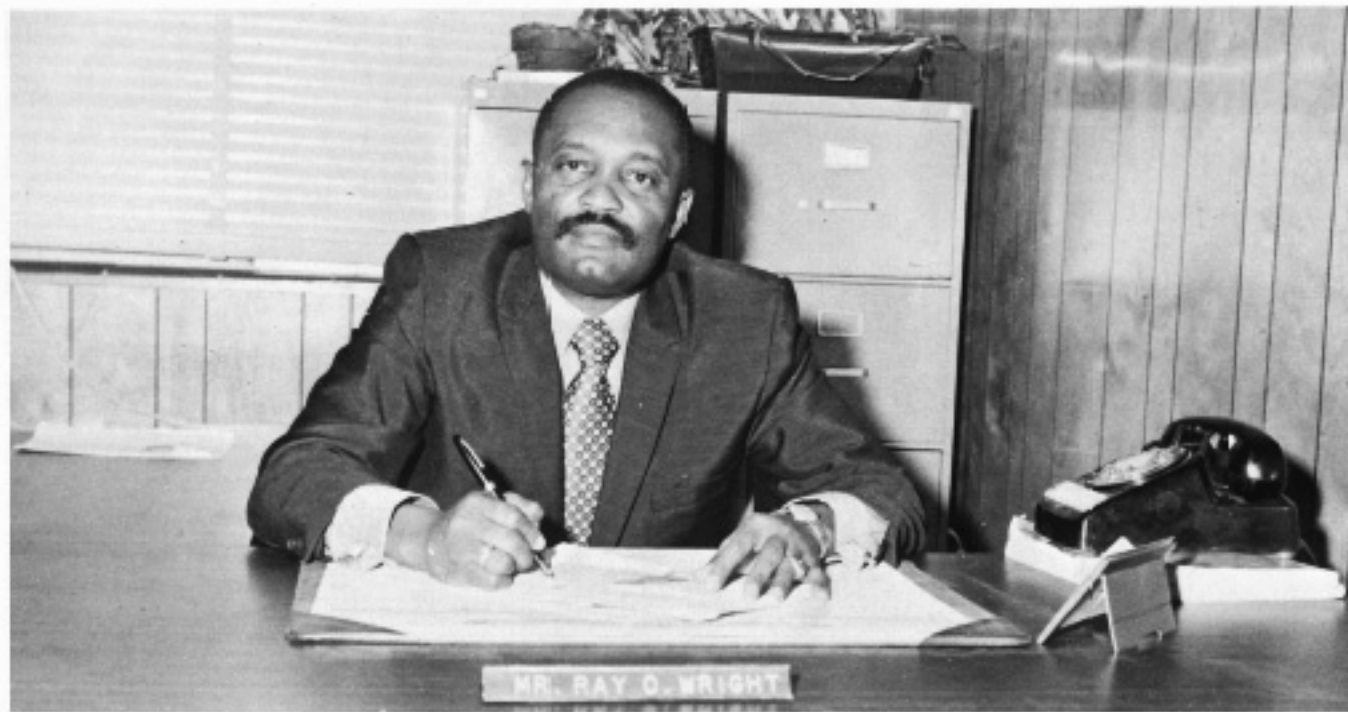

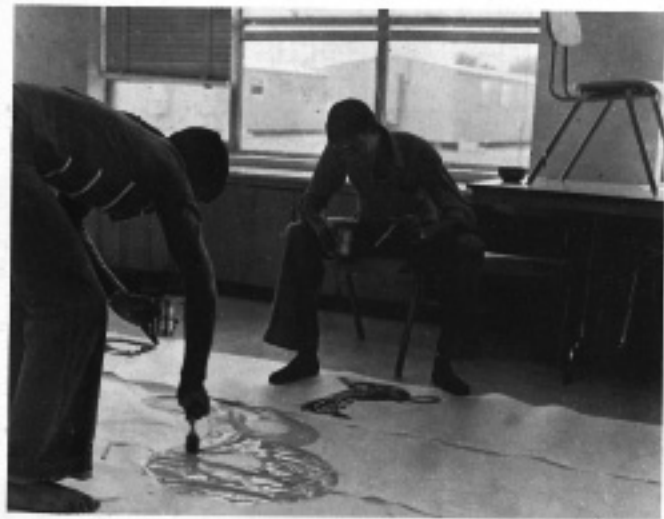

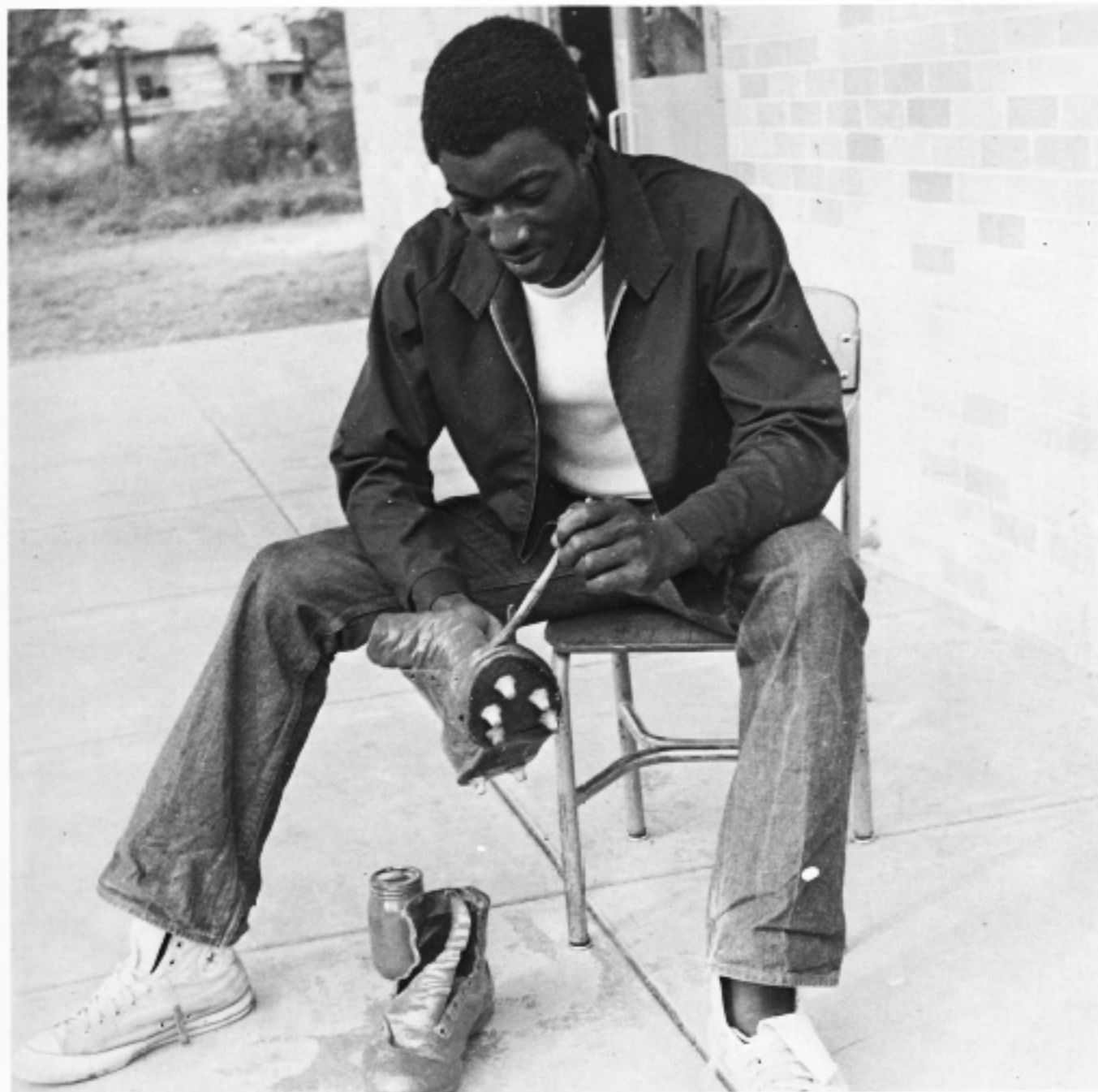

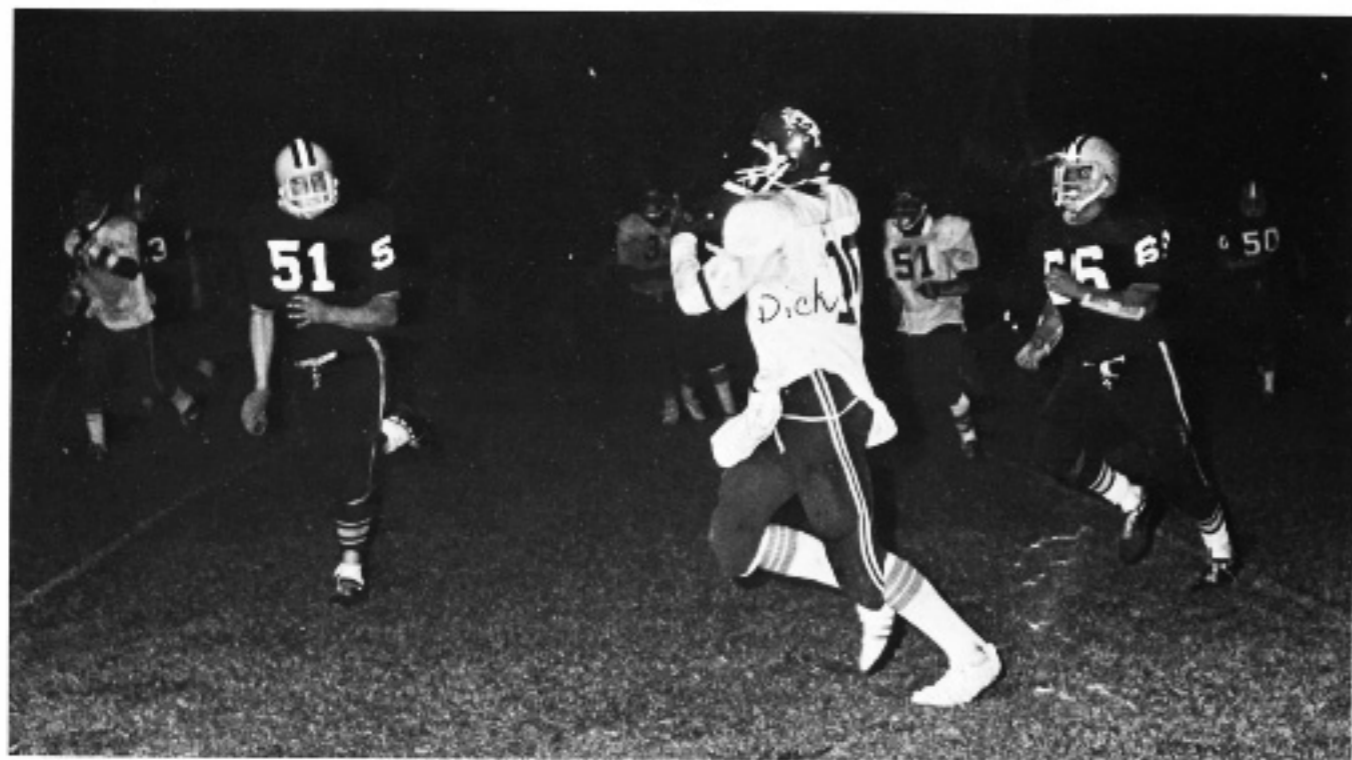
