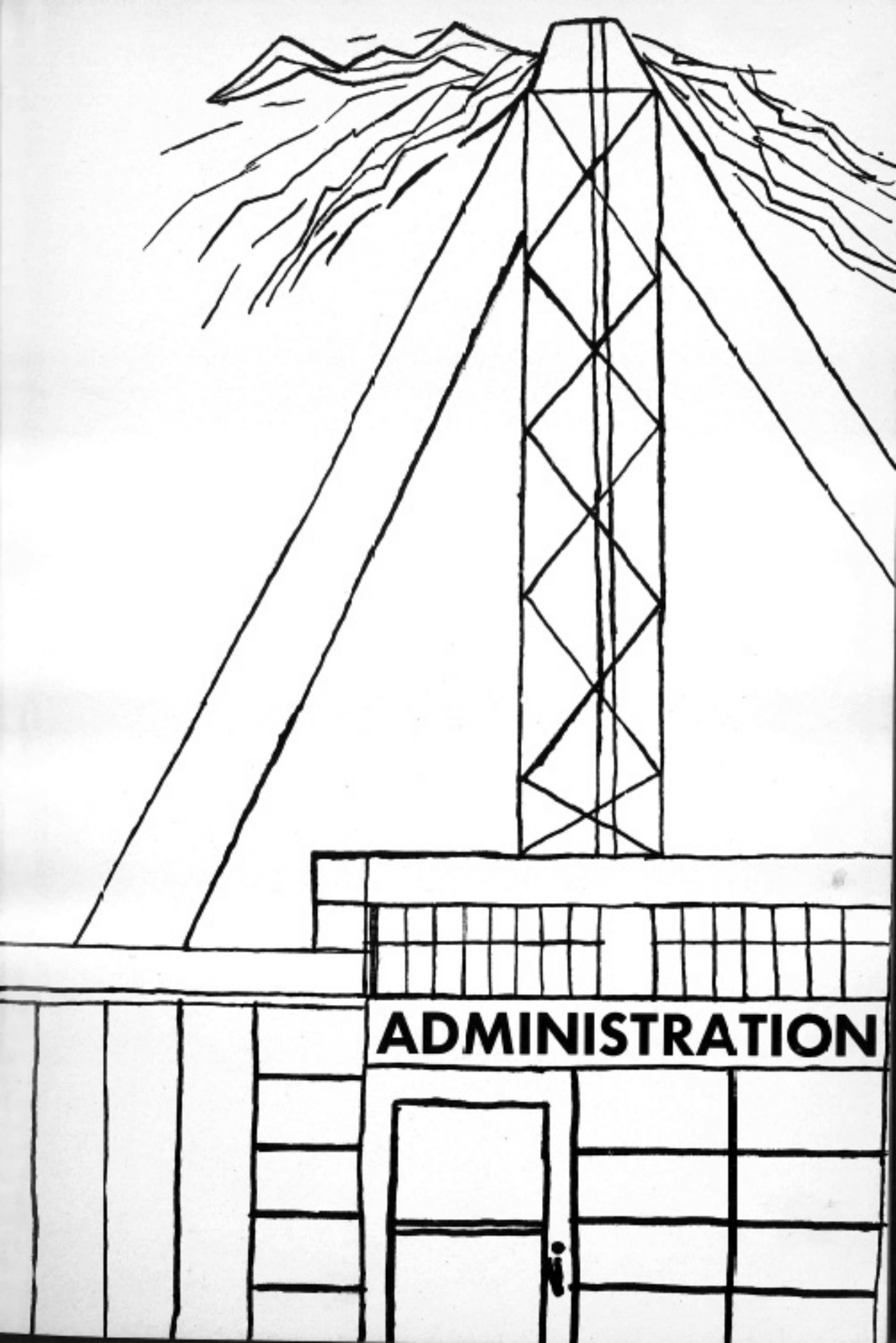

Shown above is the Carroll High School Choir under the direction of Miss Barbara E. Thomas.



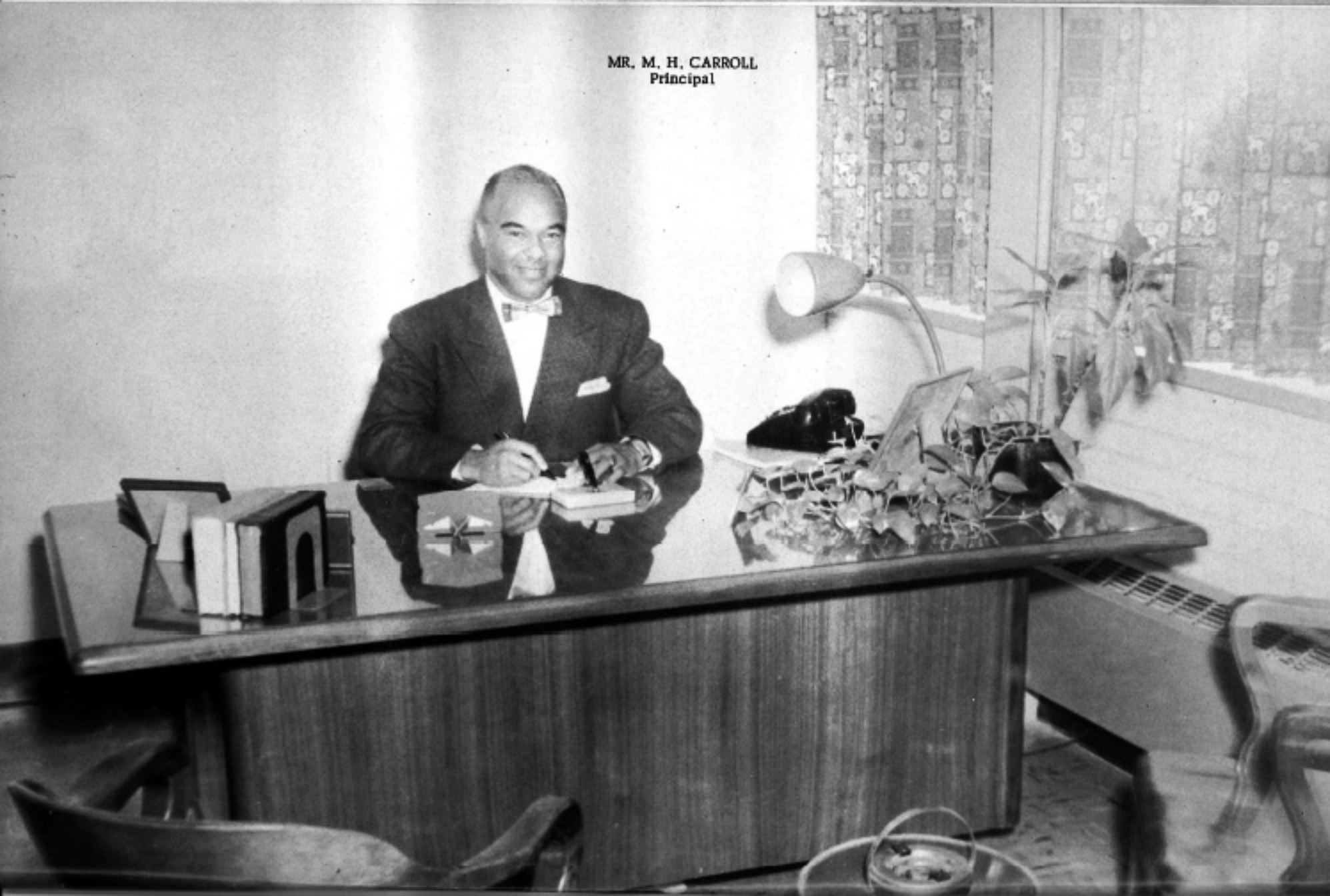



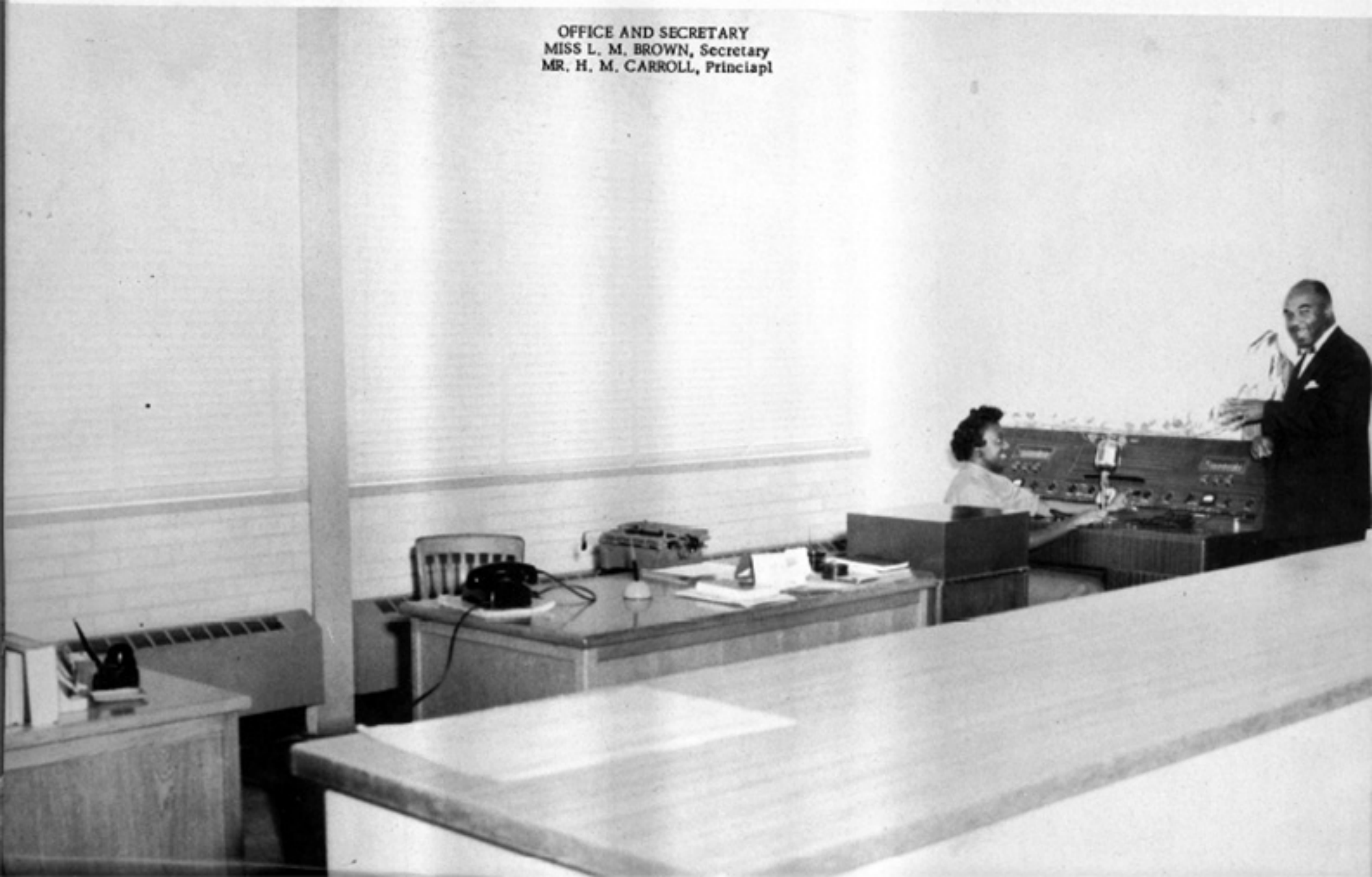
## Principal's Message



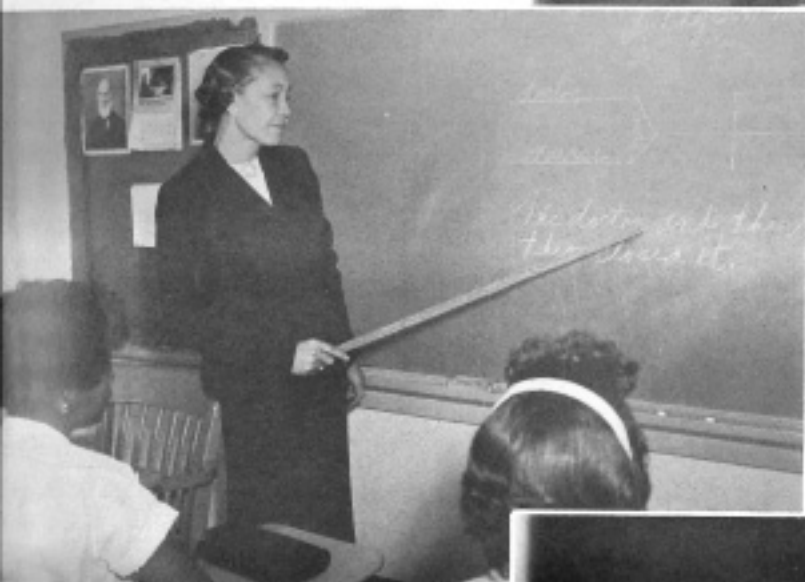

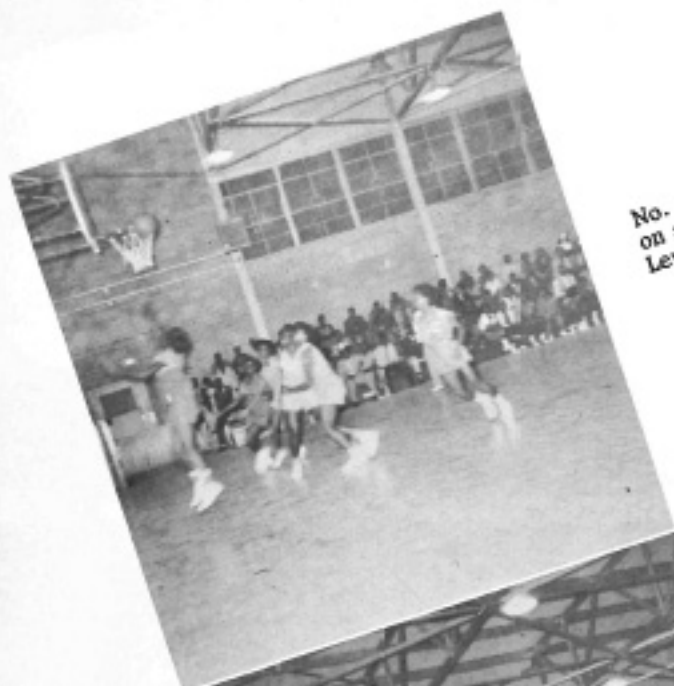
