



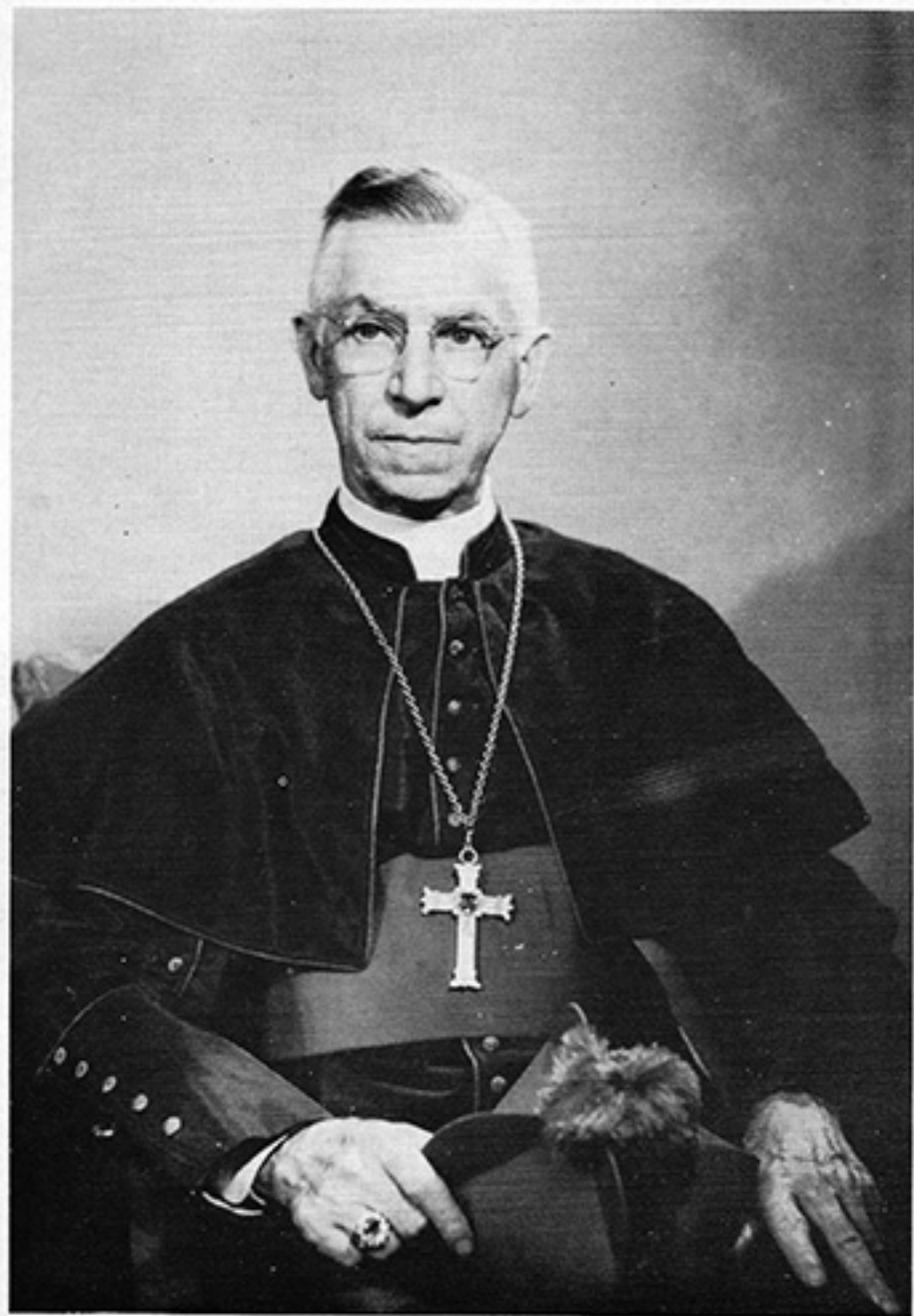

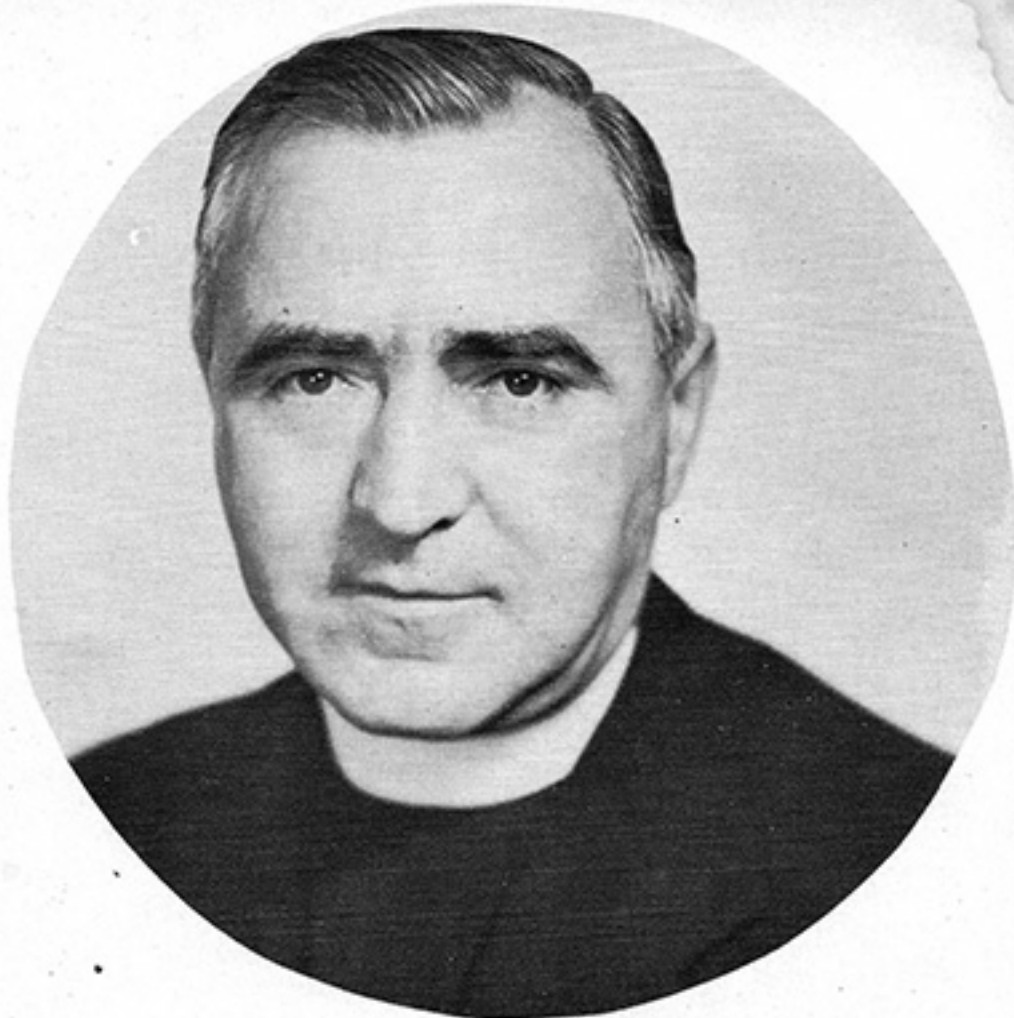

My Dear Graduates:

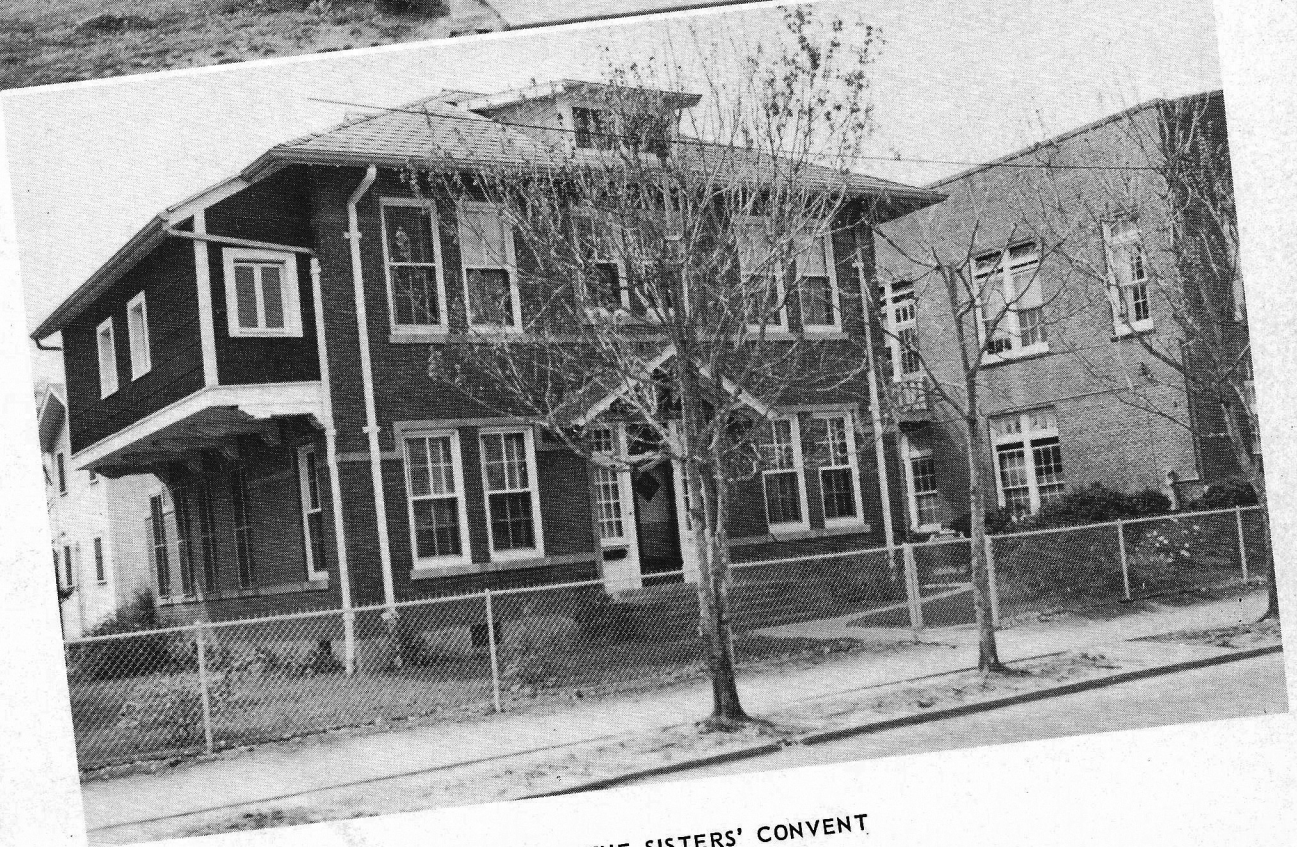

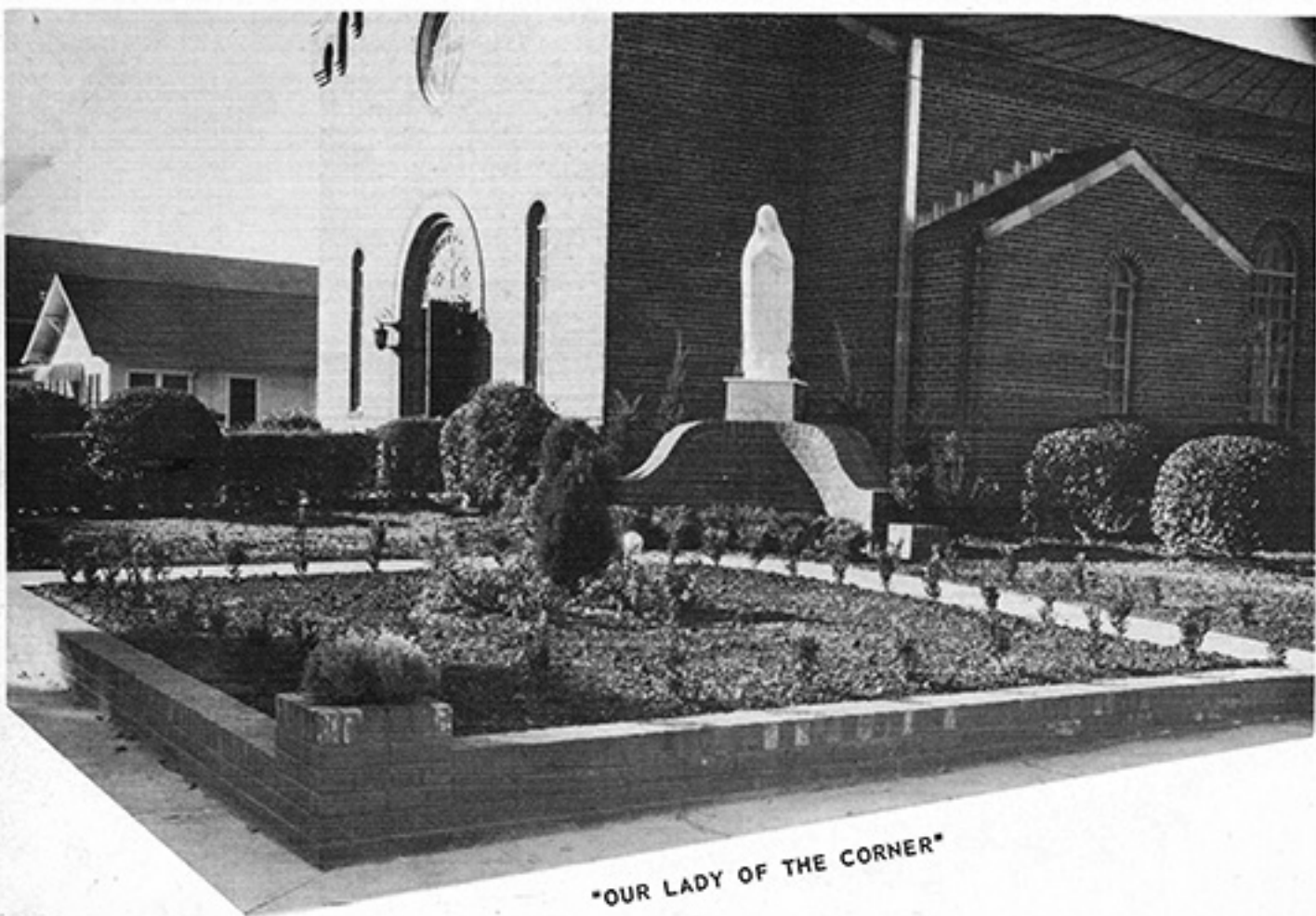
