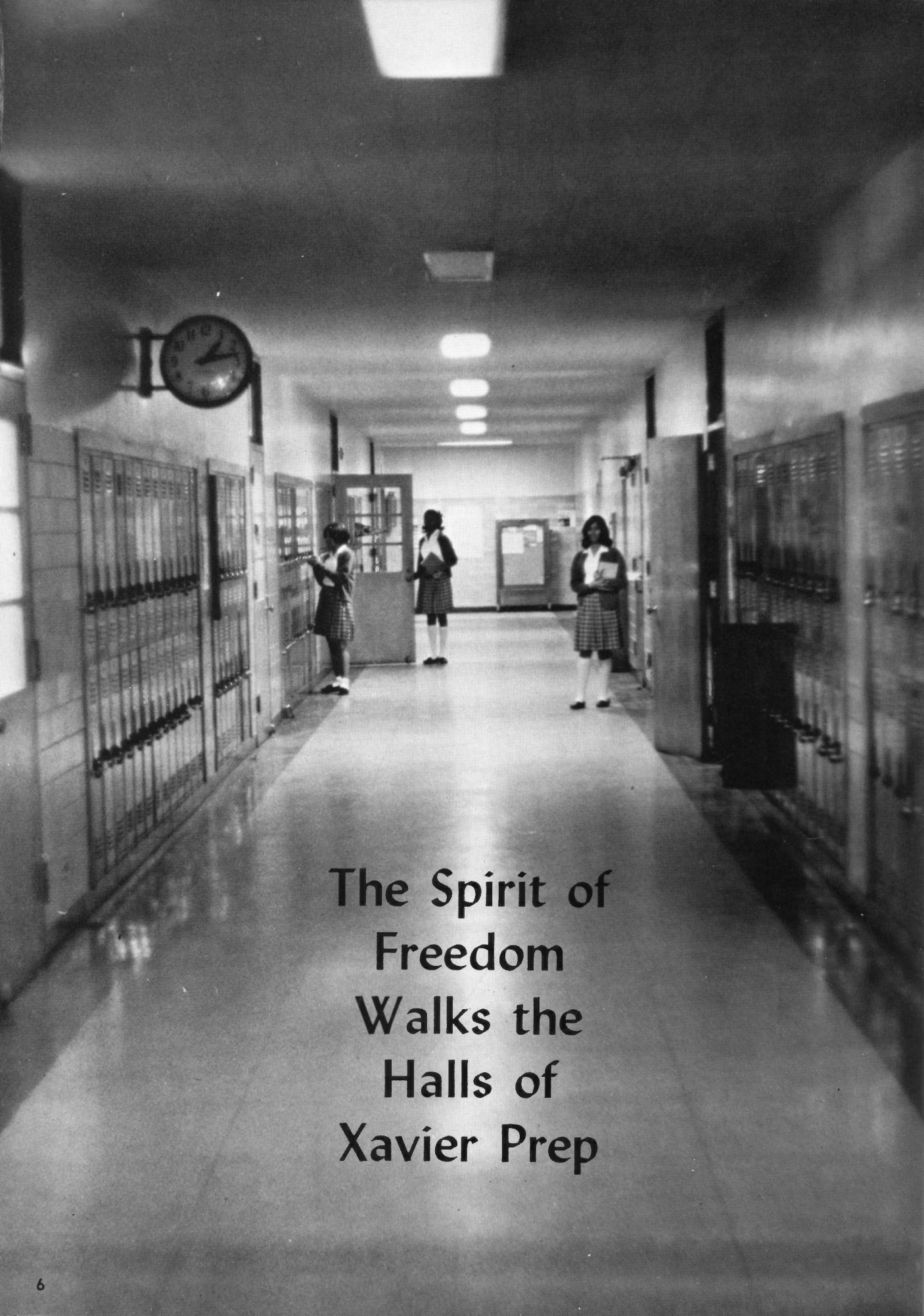

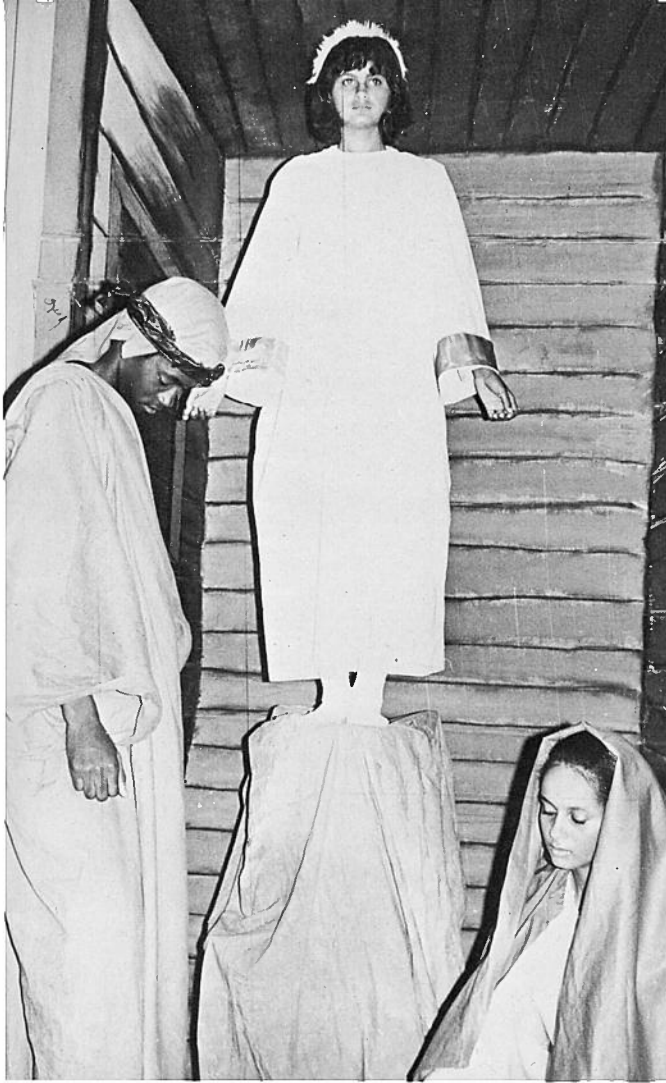

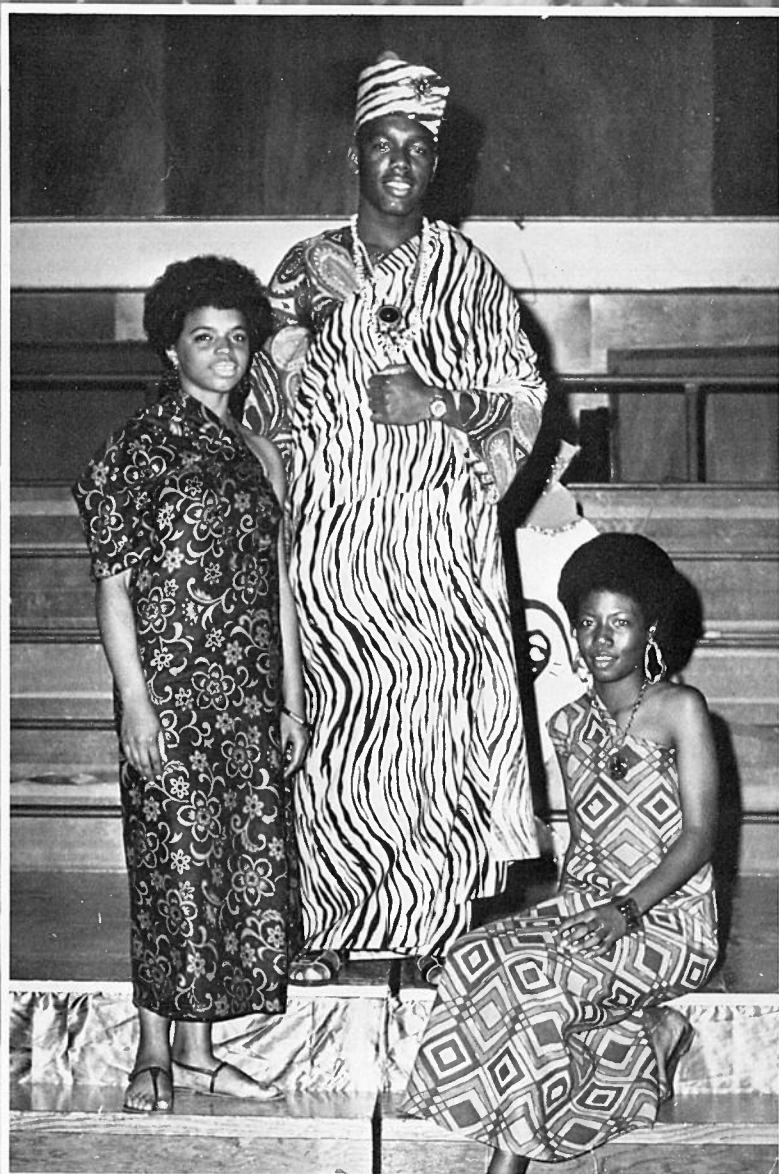

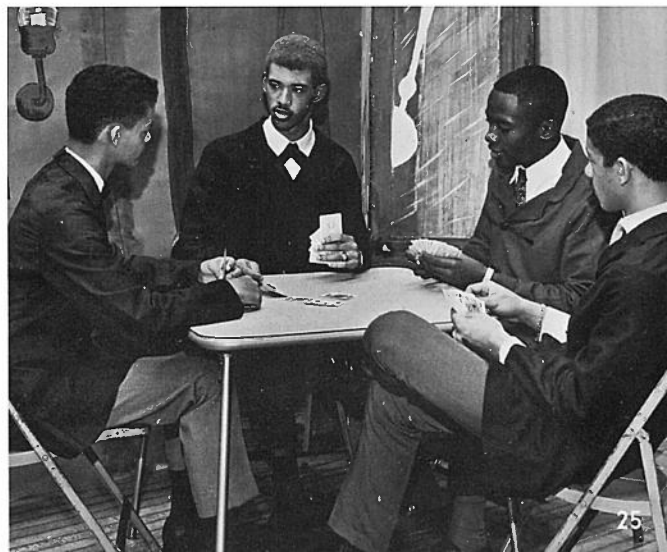
"Around the World in 80 Days"

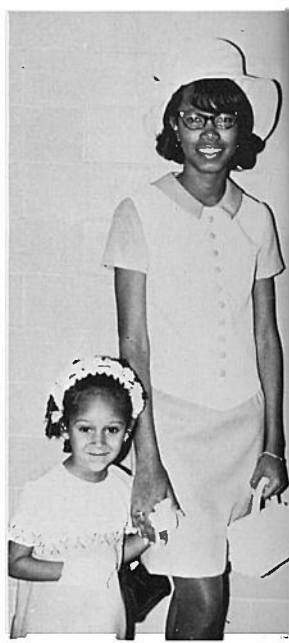

The annual Festival of music, dance, and song, held this year for the first time at the Municipal Auditorium, was an outstanding success.

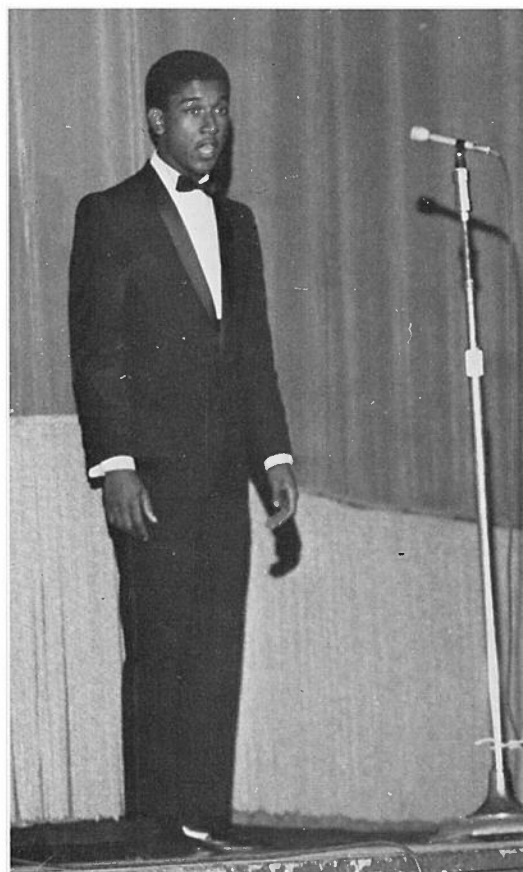

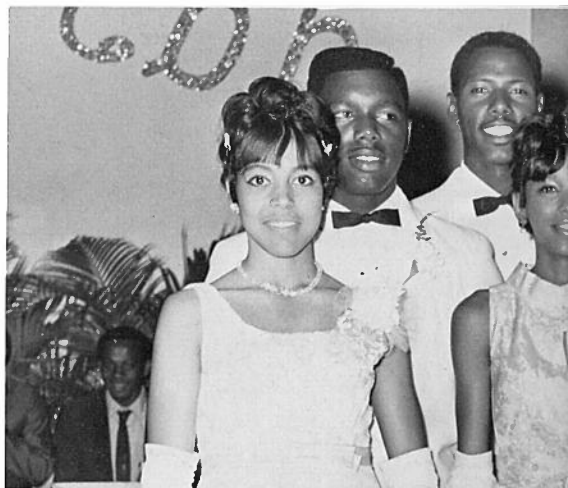

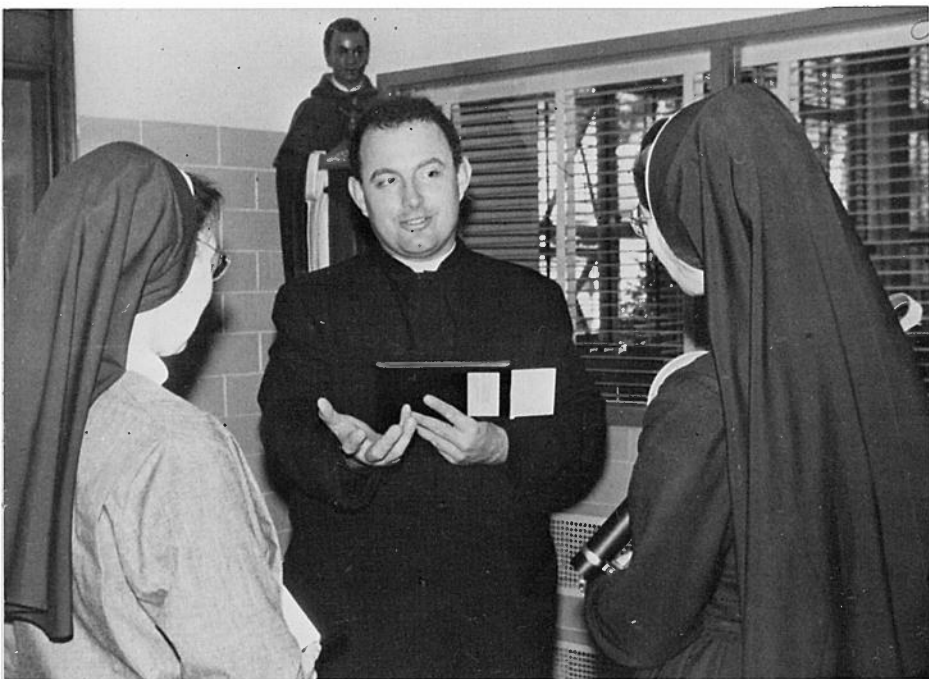

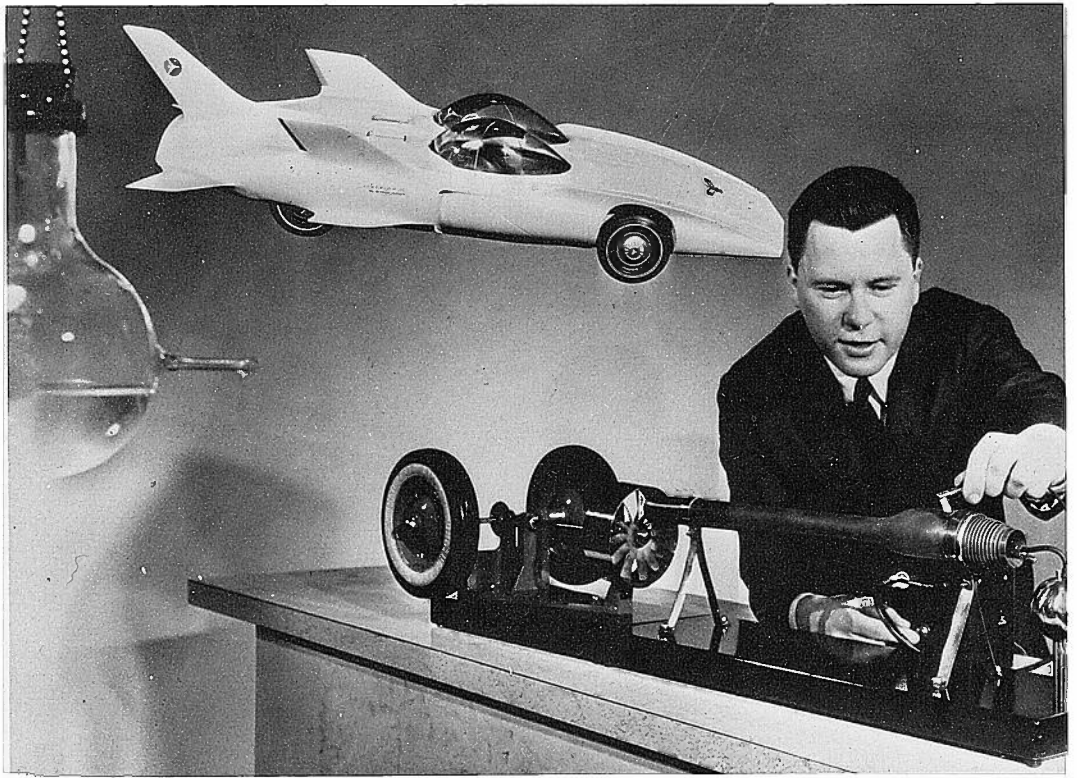
Catholic Students Mission Crusade

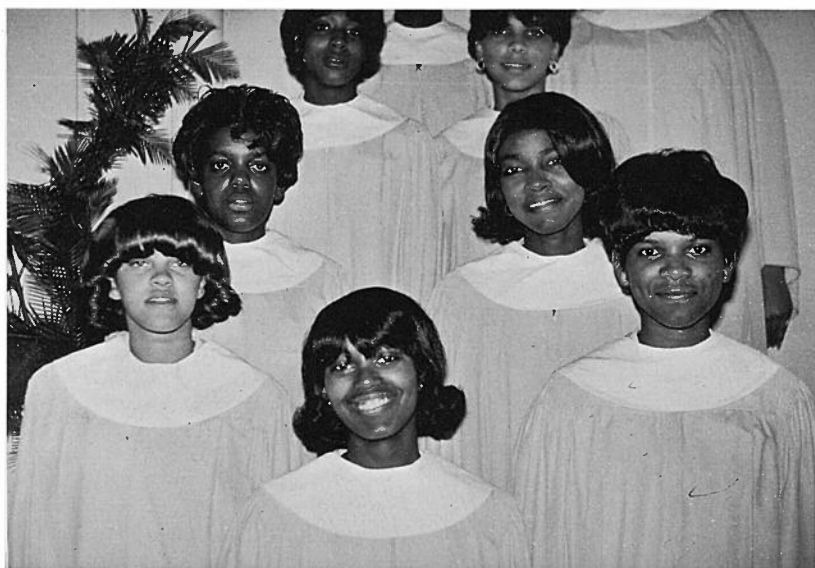

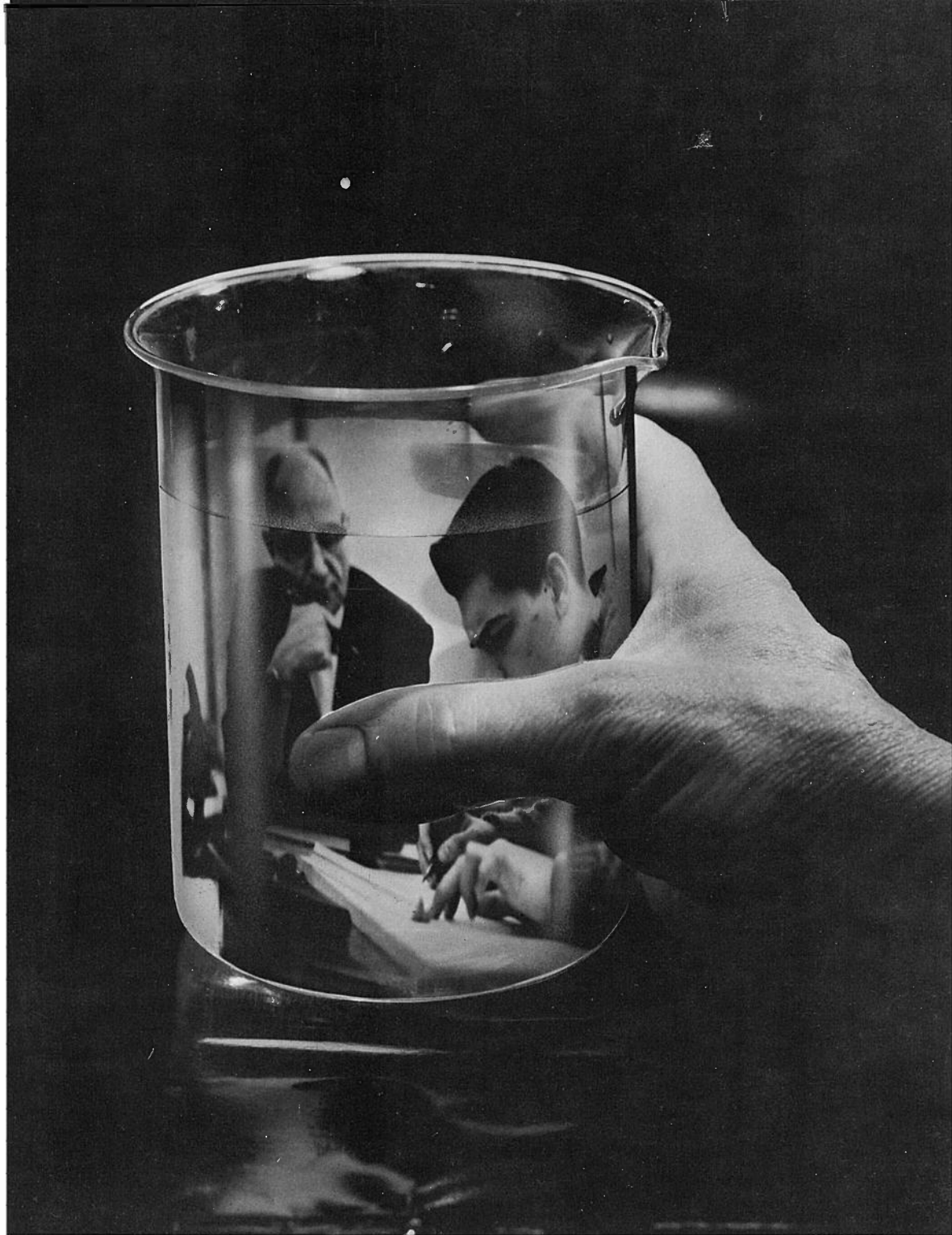

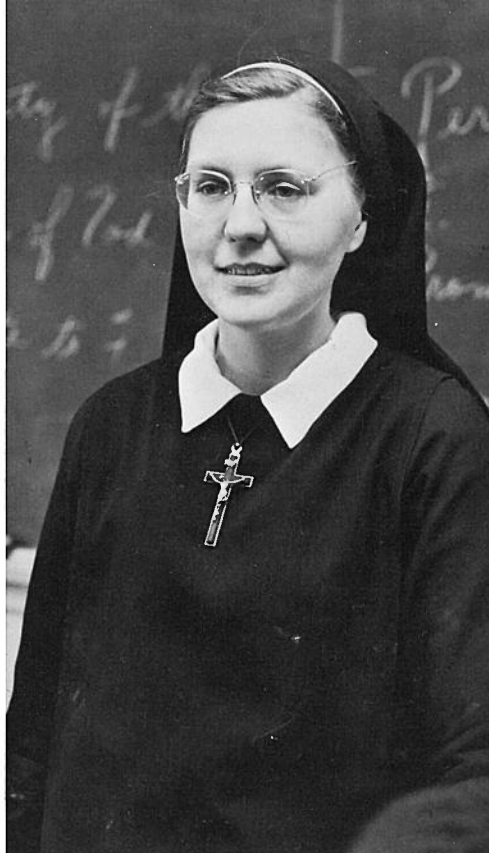

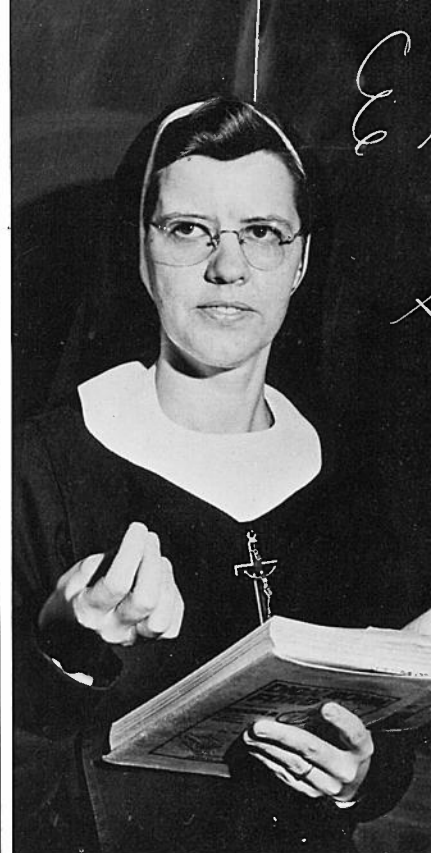

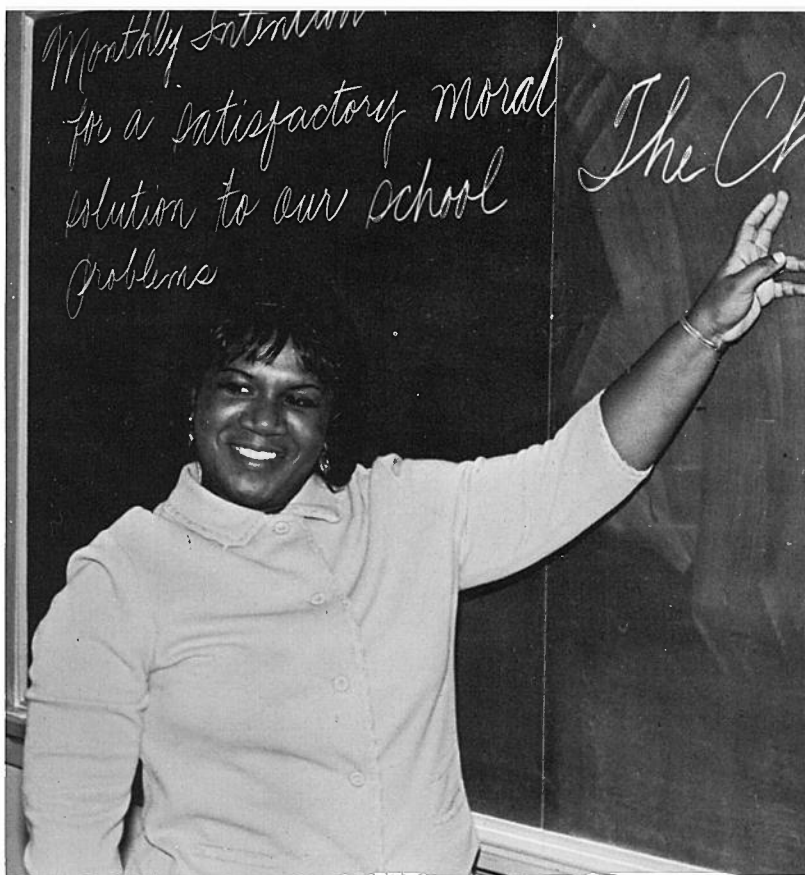

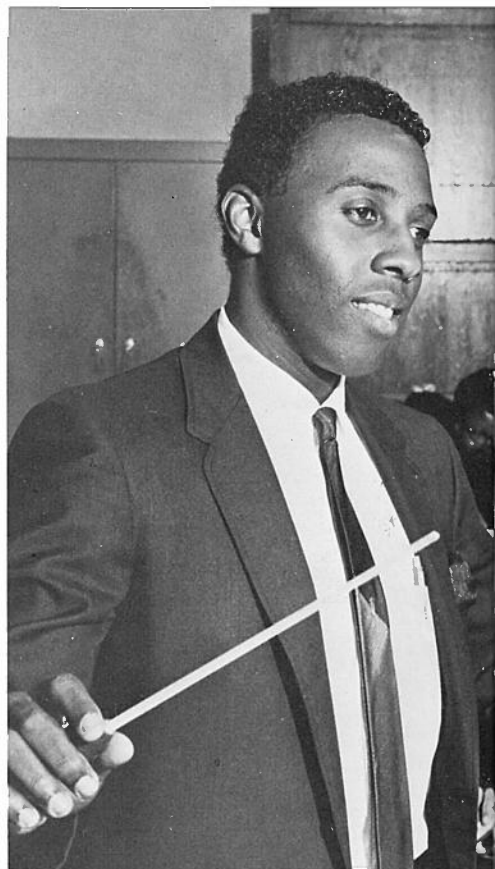

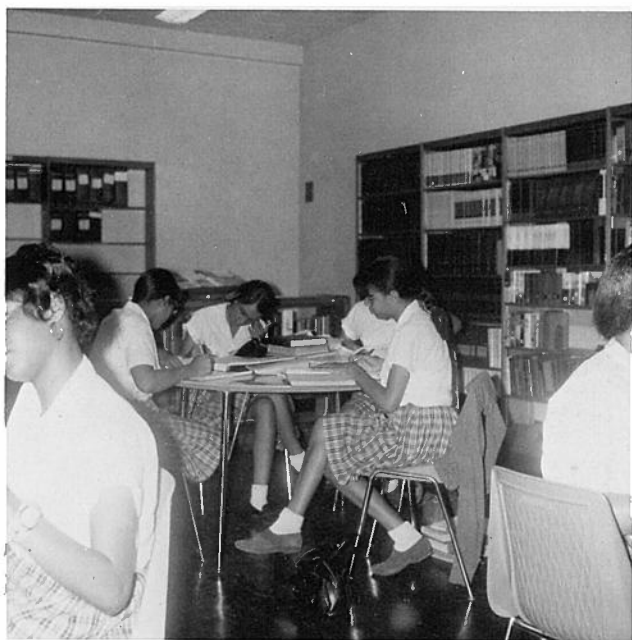

Social Studies

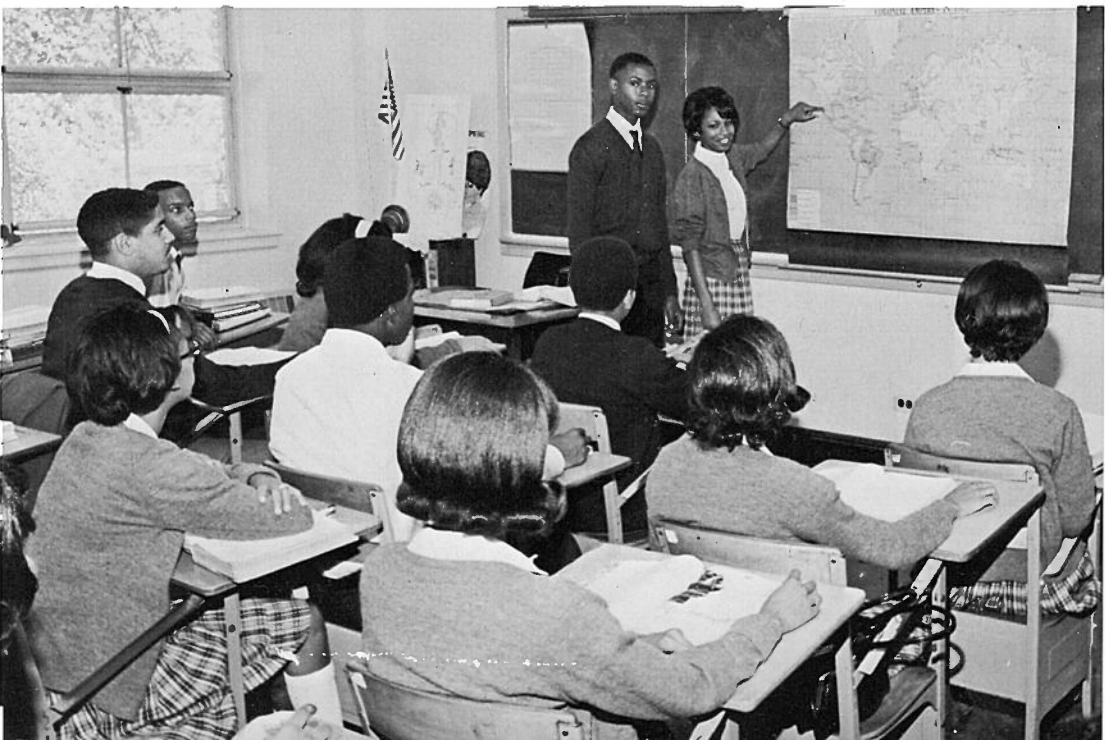

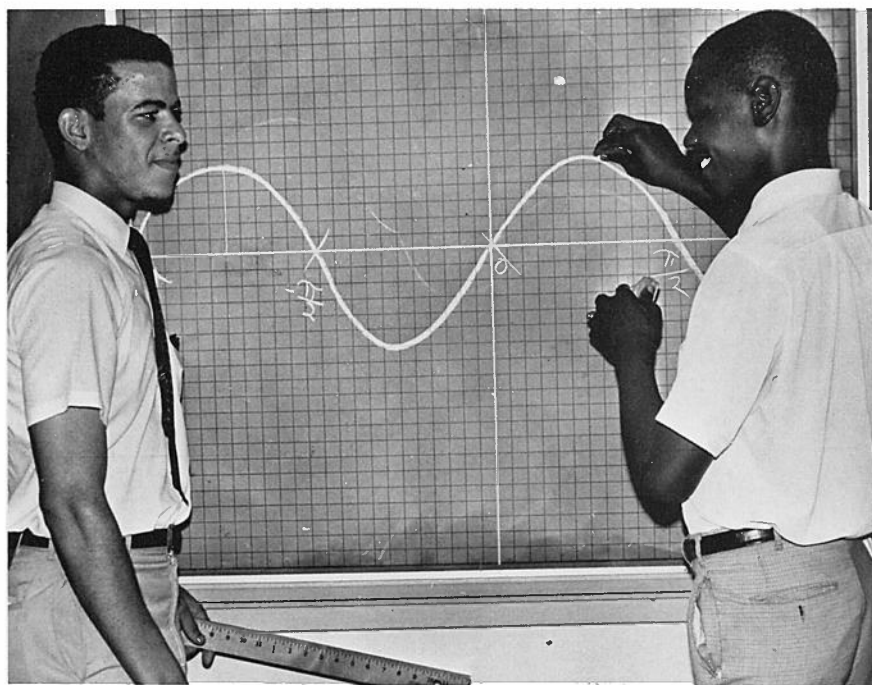

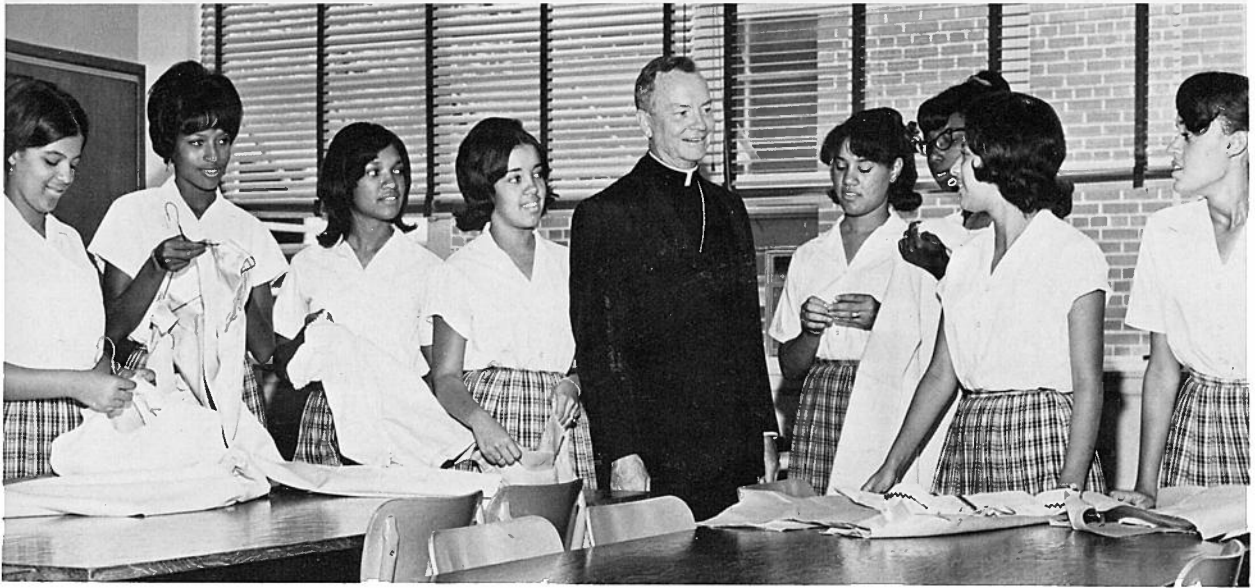

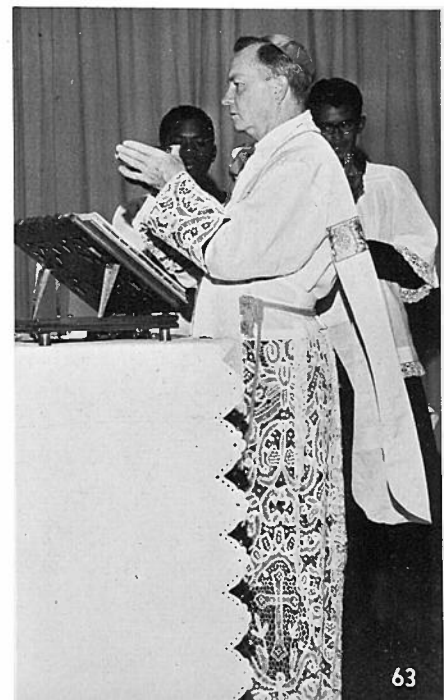
