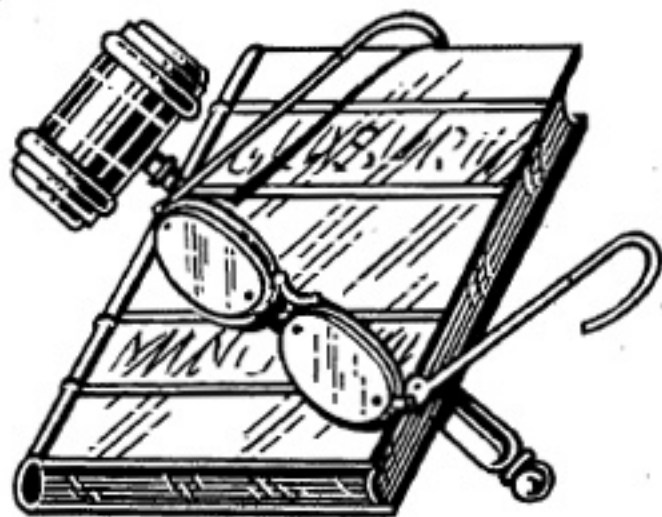


MRS. AMANDA A. GRACE
