Vermilion Native to Assume Post in South African U.

AFRICA is to be "home" for a teacher from Abbeville, La. Sarah Broussard, a member of the international Grail movement, will leave the end of this month to assume responsibility as dean of women at Pius XII university in Basutoland, South Africa.

Sarah is the second Grail member from Vermilion parish to go to Africa. Viola LaFosse,

Gueydan, spent 18 months (1959-1961) in Ruanda working at a school for retarded children.

Sarah's apostolic spirit is not a new thing. She was interested in people and what happened to them while she was gaining her bachelor of science degree at Louisiana State university. After working for a time in a bank, Sarah began her teaching career at Mount Carmel high school, Abbeville, where she remained for 13 years.

DURING this period the principal of Mt. Carmel suggested that Sarah visit Grailville, Loveland, O., national center for the Grail in America. The Grail is a movement for women, of many backgrounds and professions, working together to apply Christian values to our present-day society.

"I first went to Grailville because I was sent," Sarah said. "I returned because I felt that at last I had met real Christians and here was a chance to live a fuller Christian life."

SHE RETURNED TO Grailville in 1960 to spend a year training for more active participation in the work of the Church. Keenly interested in the

center and shyly ask, "Is Miss Broussard here?"

Adult education in Kaplan, high school discussion groups in Abbeville, religious education in Erath are all part of Sarah's life. For the past two years she also has been helping Father Albert McKnight in the co-op movement in Louisiana as well as editing the Co-op News, a newsletter reaching 850 people.

THAT IS why, when the international president of the Grail, Dr. Magdalene Oberhofer, told Sarah of the vacant post at Pius XII university, she willingly accepted the invitation. "I had already wanted to go to Africa," Sarah said, "but never thought I would have the chance. When I heard about this post, I just felt it was the right thing to do."

Pius XII university, where Sarah will assume responsibility as dean of women is located in Basutoland, an "island" of British territory within the Union of South Africa. The only Catholic college south of the

Congo, and one of four such institutions on the whole continent, Pius XII University is necessarily the focal point of higher education in that region.

UNDER the direction of the Oblate Fathers, the university began in 1953 to help form young men and women as Chris-

tian leaders with the insight to find Christian solutions to the many pressing problems of Africa.

"The African longs for truth that is certain," Father Guilbeault, one of the pioneers of the university, said. "The Christian doctrine that there is one truth for all people everywhere is the foundation on which the work at Pius XII is built." He continued, "The African student wants to know that he is part of mankind, not a segregated minority, nor, for that matter, that he comes from a segregated continent. The African has a longing for unity and we build on that."

IN PRACTICE, at Pius XII university there are certain concrete expressions of the unity and oneness that Christianity brings. When Sarah arrives at the university she will become part of an international staff, drawn from many nations. Also, as much as possible, the students are drawn from different tribes and different countries. The lives of the students are built around a community atmosphere of lectures, discussions and living together, sharing the common hopes and dreams of young Africa.

Sarah will contribute outgoingness and understanding linked with technical competence in teaching to an area hungry for learning. The new sense of economic and political expectancy in Africa has swept away indifference and apathy, and has given place to a compelling conviction of the importance of higher education. Pius XII university stands as a significant response to the tempo of this time as well as a vibrant challenge to this teacher from Abbe-

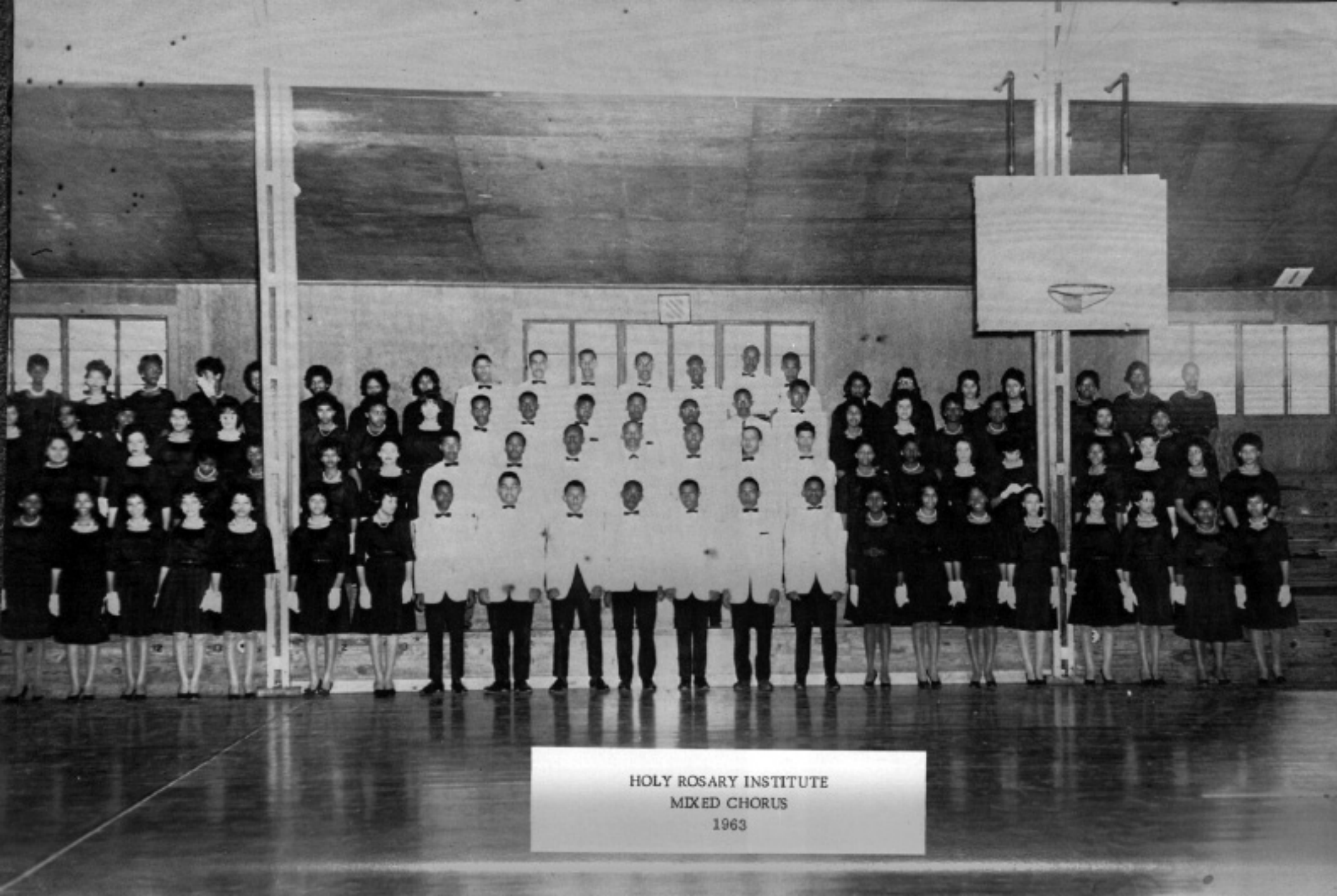

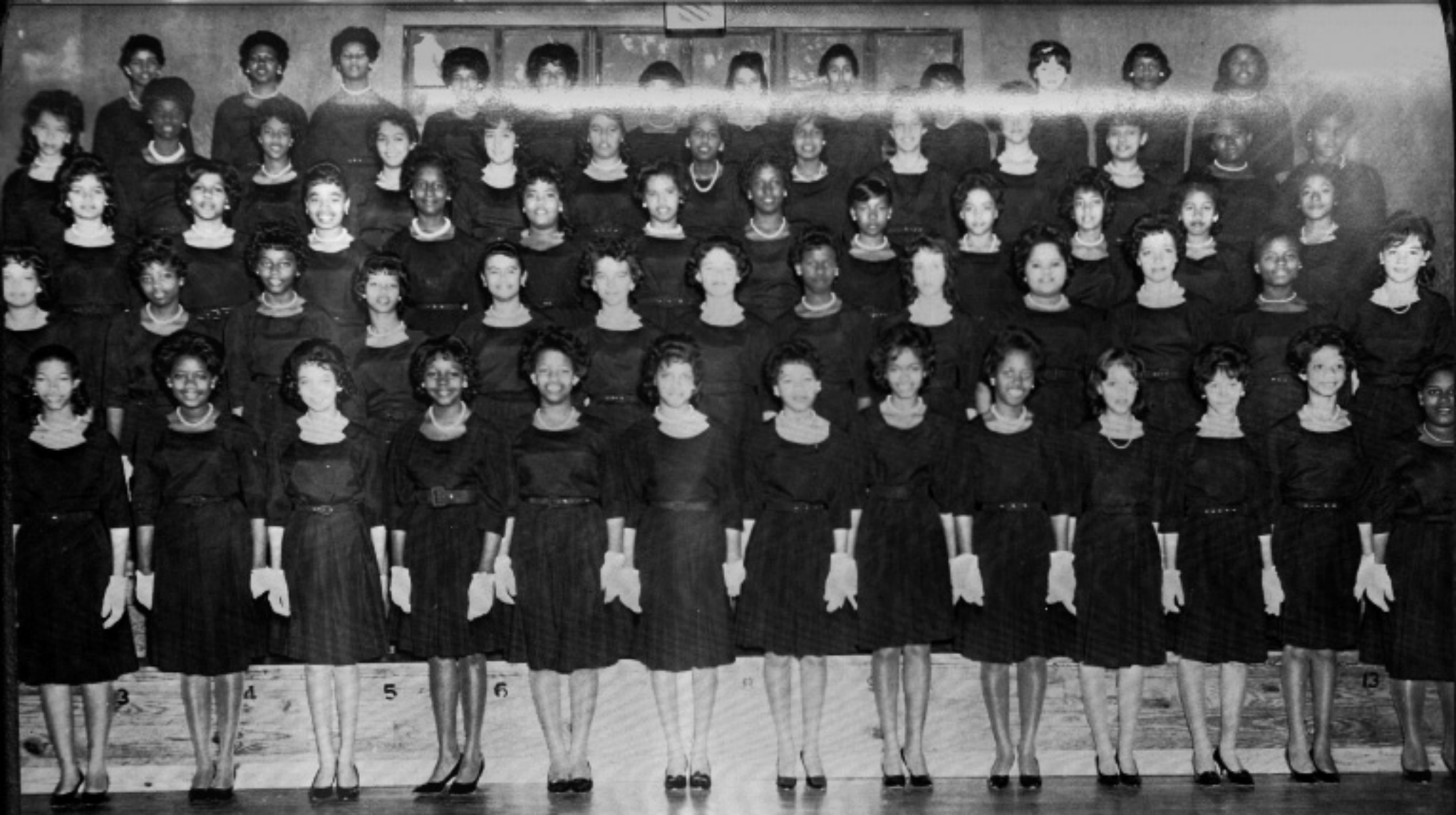

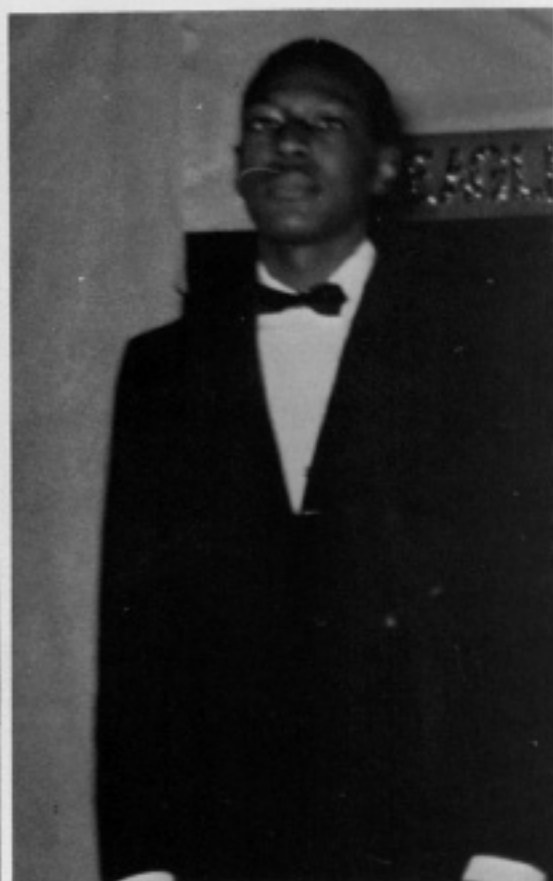
