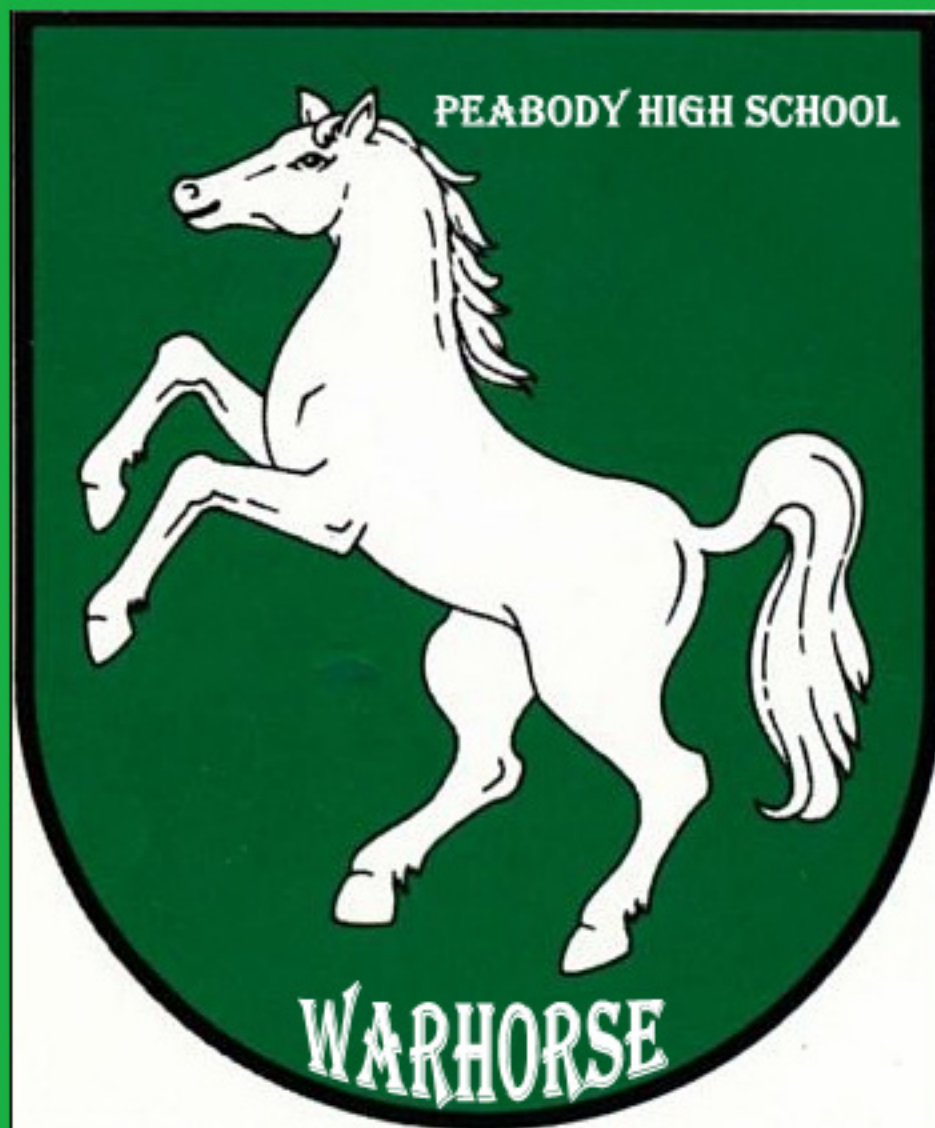

school bell.

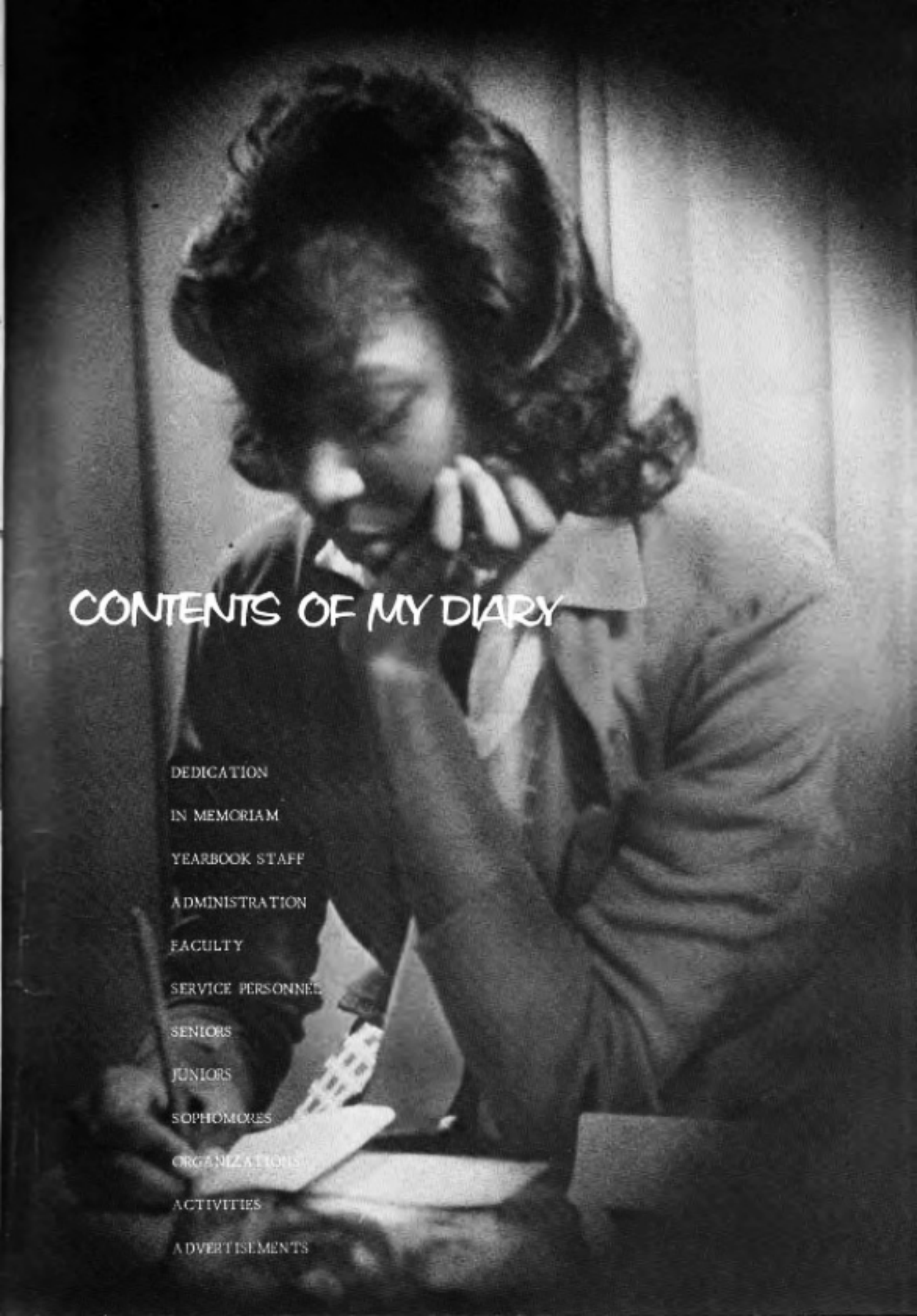
One day a hush will fall, the footsteps
