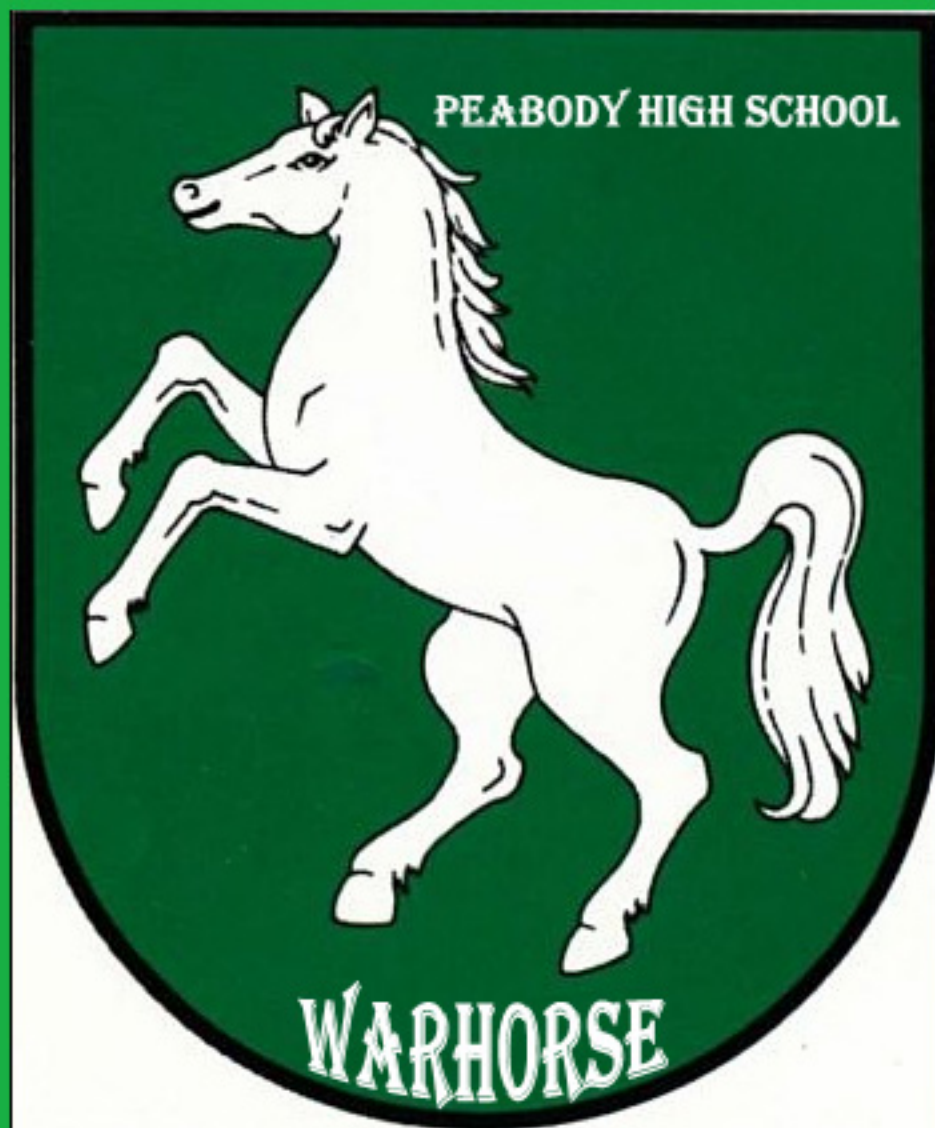

This age demands individuals with strong character and noble purpose. Try at all times to live up to the democratic principles and Christian beliefs of our country.

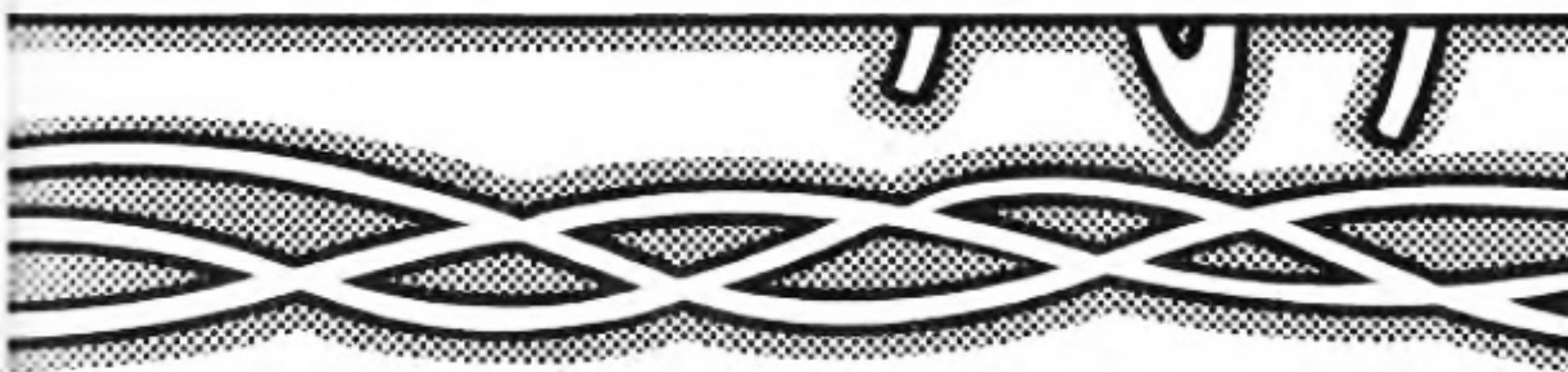

In this book, we have tried to show the dignity, and pride that the students of a brand new "Senior High" possess. Now you must decide whether or not we have reached our goal.

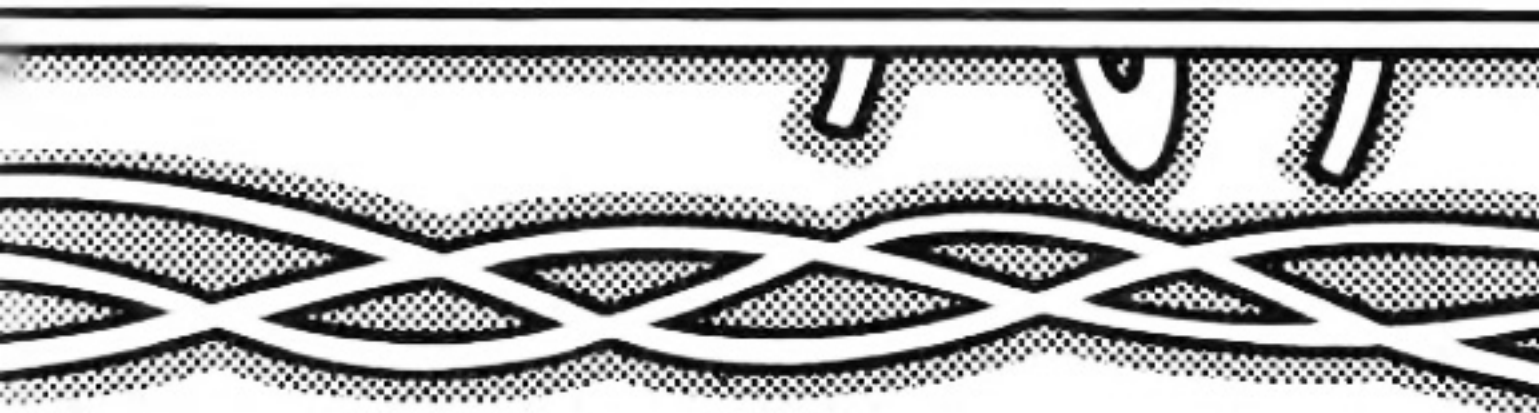
