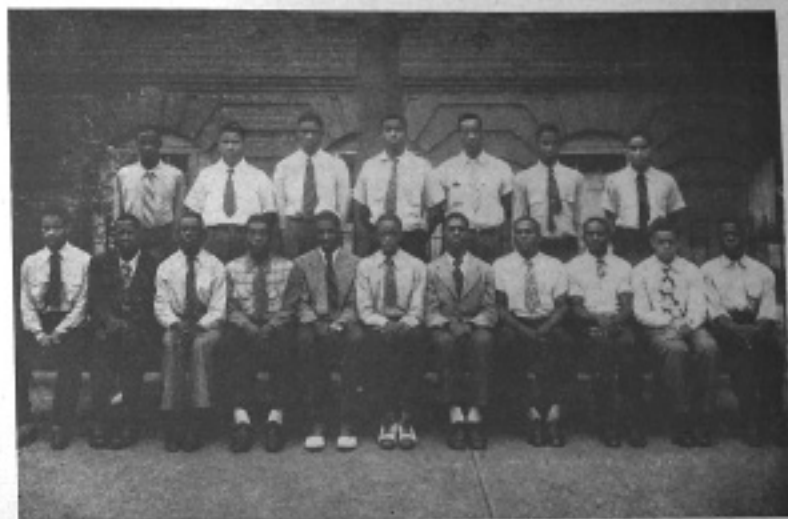

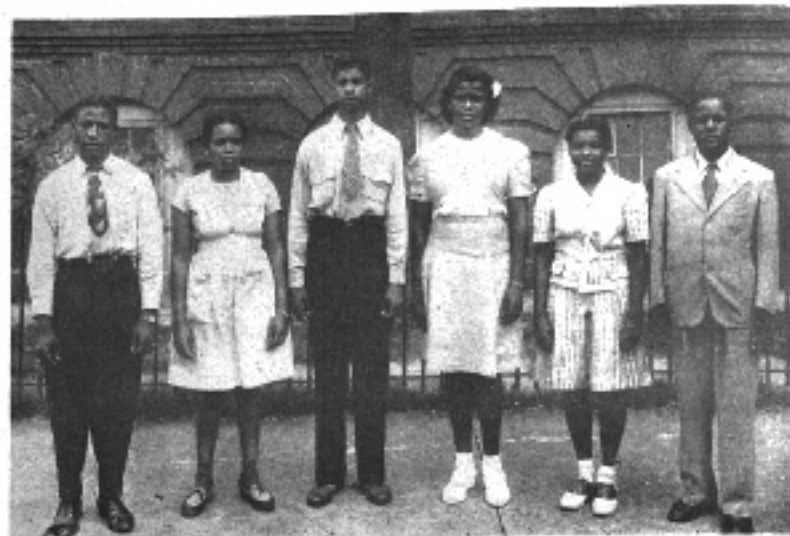
The first play given by the Dramatic Club was a "Columbus Day" program with the history department as its guest.

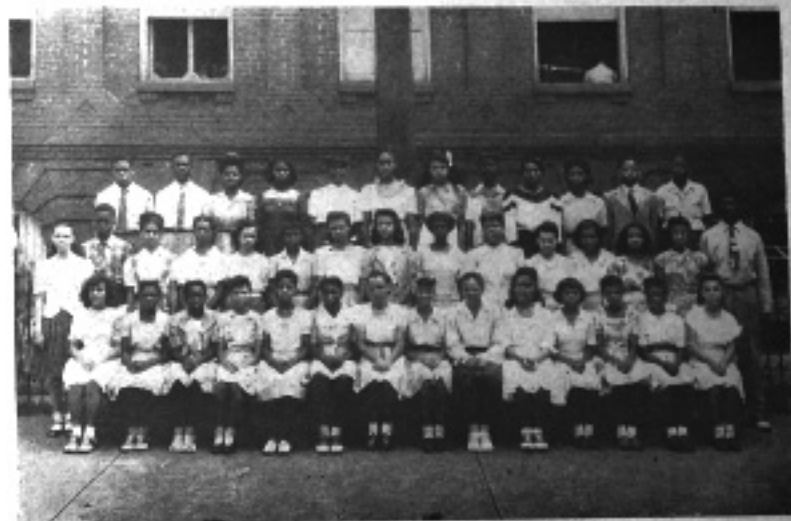

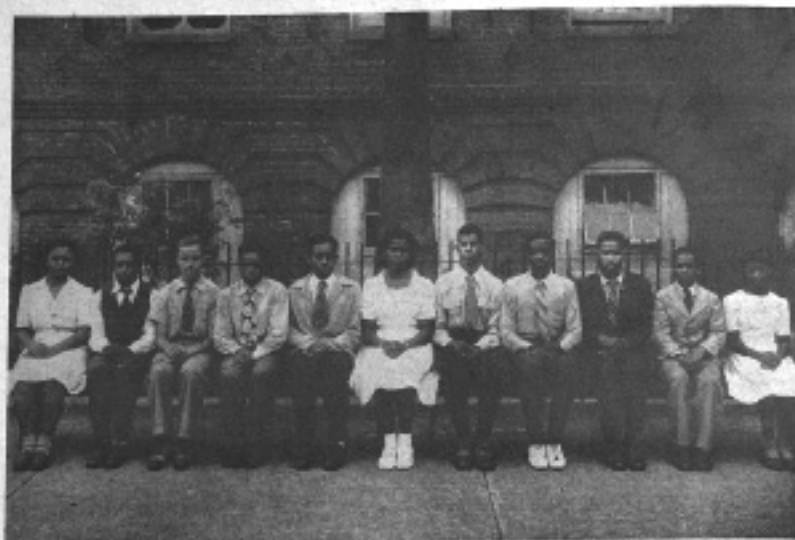
