

As the centuries, one after another, glide by, revelations more and more marvelous are brought to the world. Perhaps the most extraordinary discovery of modern times is that of the Roneagle. This bird, beyond doubt the mightiest, swiftest, and most resourceful of all winged creatures, resembles in some respects the great American bald eagle. The Roneagle, however, is far larger in size and it possesses a tremendous advantage over the other bird in that, through Mother Nature's wondrous inventiveness, its body, head, eyes, beak, breast, wings, talons, beak, muscular system and organs, is fashioned in Solid Iron! Because of this singular trait, which appears more miraculous when one discovers the bird accomplishing feats which, because of the great weight of even the iron feathers of its mighty pinions, would seem reasonably impossible, the creature became known as the Roneagle—the IRON EAGLE.

In only one spot in the world, the giant industrial structure known as Mc Donogh #35 High and Normal School, has the Roneagle chosen its lair. There, beset with dangers before which weaker birds misdeed, the Roneagle lives and thrives, requiring five years to evolve from the egg to the adult stage. Persons who have braved the blistering heat, the bitter cold, the furious storms of one or another of winter, and thunder and lightning, constantly vents its fury about the lair of the Roneagle, have been persuaded so that the bird feeds on only hard, cold iron. This substance of iron contributes much to the development of the bird's prodigious prowess and the bird's strength.

The first step of the life cycle of the Roneagle is known as the embryonic stage. Twice a year—in early September and late January—a number of eggs are brought into the world. From what has been said before, it will not seem strange to the reader that these great eggs are encased in shells of glittering steel, the reflection of which, as they glisten in the sunlight, is too strong for the naked eye. Each egg, protected by its strong armor from the dangers that await above, operates upon iron, which gradually takes the form of a tiny Roneagle.

By the end of the year, the young creature is so strong and sturdy as to break its steel prison, and a young Roneagle finds itself for the first time in the world of living things. The bird is, of course, much dependent; and it becomes the duty of old, weathered Roneagles to bring to its next daily portions of baby iron-food.

A year passes by, and the Roneagle reaches the first stage of its life history. The smooth and jagged iron feathers of its wings are now sufficiently strong for the young creature to make its first attempts at flying. By the end of the year, the bird has become a reasonably expert pilot itself in the air beyond the nest. And what rejoicing fills the air as the first Roneagle's flight is seen! The fact that the young bird has acquired enough strength and skill to fly means it is now accompanied by other Roneagles!

During the fourth step of the life cycle of the marvelous bird, it seems to know no other delight in out-distancing other winged creatures in flight. Much as the bird is unconscious of wind or rain or snow, its mighty pinions majestically surge and the Roneagle races its way through the thin air with the speed of lightning.

Finally, during the fifth year after the laying of the great steel-shelled egg, the Roneagle enters into the adult stage. Now the bird, having now lived upon iron for two years on the most substantial of iron food; having been hardened by storm and sleet, by summer's torrid heat and winter's punishing cold; and having gained in strength and in tactics through participation in numerous contests, becomes a most wonderful creature. Among some industrial aviators, having piloted airplanes far above the top of the world, has been an adult Roneagle. It has by this time taken to its many stunts and conquered countless adversaries. It is probably accompanied in some way by a certain constant, its mighty talons raving the jagged rock, its great iron body glittering and its fierce steel eyes, alive with lightning, slowly seeking among the far distant stars new worlds to conquer.




# HOMECOMING
