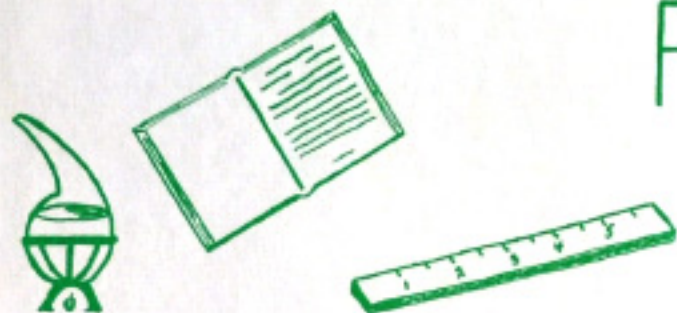

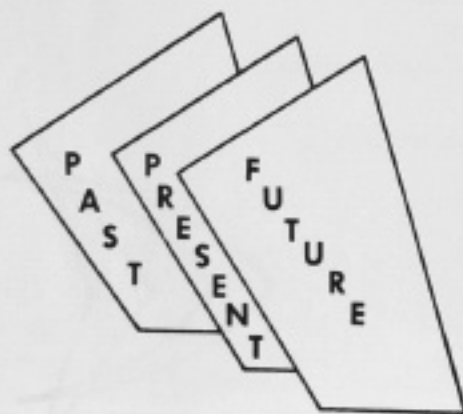
Foreword

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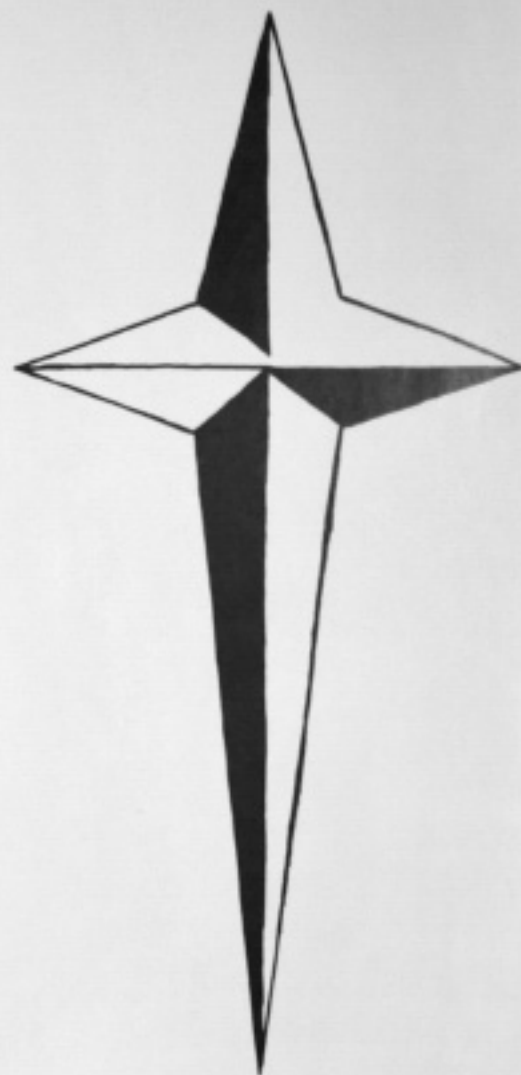
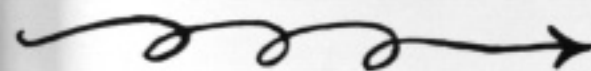


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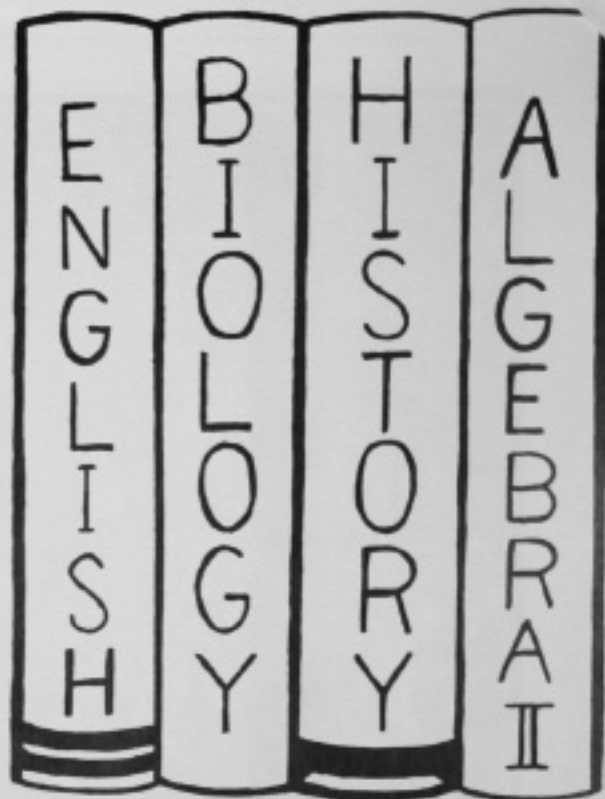


GWENDOLYN M. PHOENIX

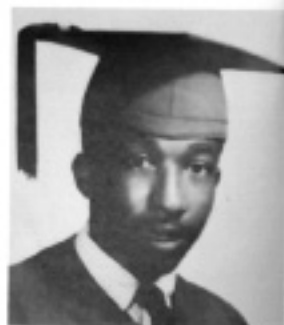

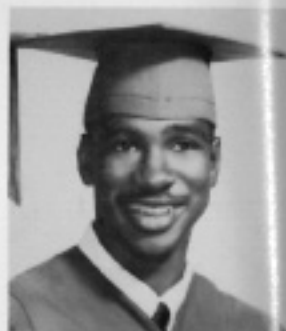

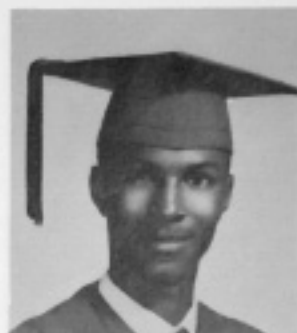

And how what seemed reproof was love most true.

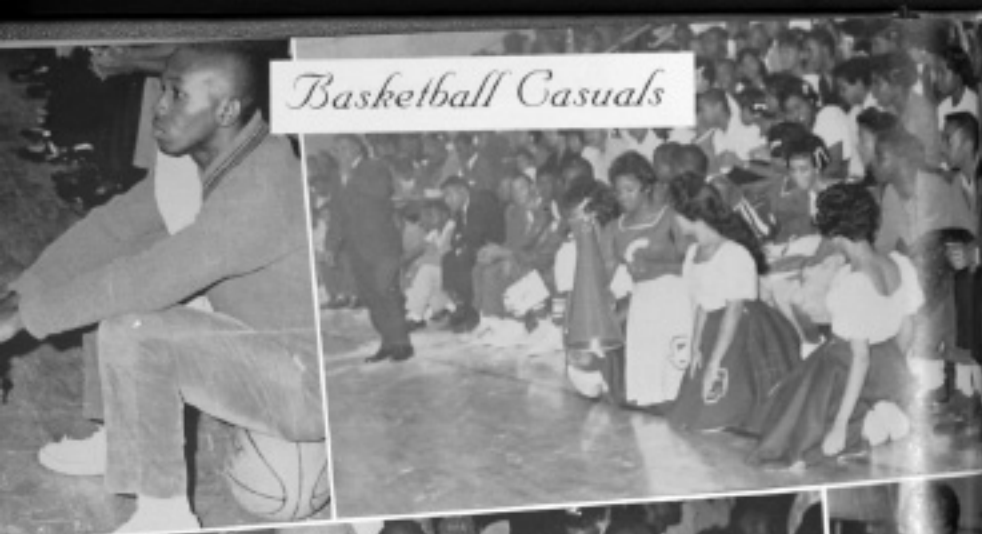
And if, sometimes, commingled with life's wine,

And for each mystery could find a key.

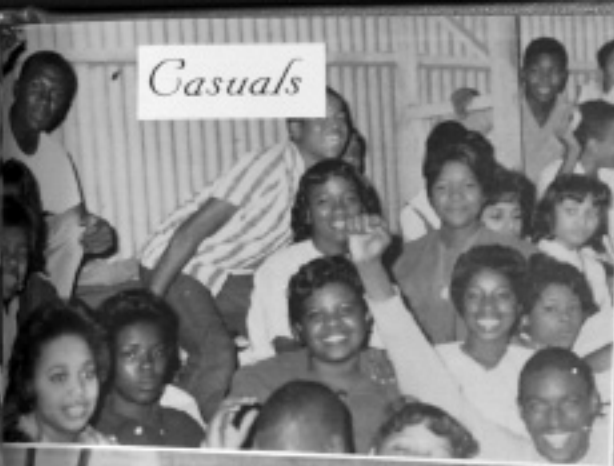
But not today. Then be content, poor heart;

Kennedy consulted with aides abroad and with political aides at home, including phone calls Friday to the three living presidents, before going and with what aides termed a carefully considered decision to make tests.

Speaking earnestly from a press text, the President mixed warning of Soviet designs with promises to hold danger of radioactive fallout from the tests to a minimum.

He stressed his treaty of saying "it is our hope and goal that these grim, unwelcome tests will never have to be made."

SOVIET CAPABILITY SEEN
Kennedy said that results of extensive studies by U. S. agencies reviewed at a final National Security Council meeting last week showed the Soviet tests could be a springboard for moving the atomic balance in communists' favor.

"I must report to you in all candor," he said, "that further Soviet series, in the absence of further Western progress, could well provide the Soviet Union with a nuclear attack and defense capability so great as to encourage aggressive designs."

U. S. unwillingness to test would be seen by the Soviets as a sign of weakness while testing could strengthen peace preserving notice on the part of the West will stand still while Russia

THEY TO CHOOSE
The decision was pinned directly on

the free world, demand that the United States proceed with its testing. At the same time, he blamed the Russians for U.S. resumption, deplored the step-up in the arms race, and declared that the Soviet Union has the power, through agreeing to a test ban treaty, to bring to a halt the mushrooming atomic race.

"In short," Kennedy said, "in the absence of a firm agreement that would halt nuclear tests by the latter part of April, we shall go ahead with our talks at Geneva—striving for some new avenue of agreement—but we shall also go ahead with our tests."

"If, on the other hand, the Soviet Union should accept such a treaty in the opening month of talks, that single step would be a monumental step toward peace—and both Prime Minister Macmillan and I would think it fitting to meet Chairman Khrushchev at Geneva to sign the final pact."

"It is our hope and prayer that these grim, unwelcome tests will never have to be made—that these deadly weapons will never have to be fired—and that our preparations for war will bring us the preservation of peace."

CONTROL OF FORCE AIM

"Our foremost aim is the control of force, not the pursuit of force, in a world made safe for mankind."

The President concluded that, without the safeguard to American security of a nuclear test ban treaty with "detection and verification" controls to make it fully effective against any violations, the United States has no choice but to go ahead with the advancement of its atomic arsenal.

"Whatever the future brings," Kennedy said, "I am sworn to uphold and defend the freedom of the American people—and I in-

on the Pacific south of Hawaii. He said the only atmospheric tests to be conducted will be those which could not be staged underground.

Kennedy said the scope and justification for tests had been carefully reviewed to restrict them to those essential to military scientific progress.

WILL LIMIT FALLOUT

"Careful attention has been given to the limiting of radioactive fallout, to the future course of arms control diplomacy and our obligations to other nations," he said.

The United States and Britain already have presented the Soviets with a proposed treaty outlawing atomic tests. But, after more than three years of three power talks at Geneva, negotiations broke down last January over Russian refusal to allow inspection, which the Western powers argued is necessary to make a test treaty trustworthy.

Kennedy's speech was aimed for both United States and world consumption, and for Khrushchev, who has yet to say what he will do about the disarmament parley starting March 14.

The United States and Britain want Khrushchev to send his foreign minister, Andrei A. Gromyko, to Geneva shortly in advance of the conference and they want to launch the conference at the foreign-minister level. Khrushchev's bid to start off at the summit has been turned down by the West.

U.S. NEGOTIATORS READY

Kennedy, in suggesting a summit gathering with Macmillan and Khrushchev to sign a test ban treaty, said U.S. negotiators will be ready to talk about the treaty "even before the conference begins on March 14—and they will be ready to sign well before it."
