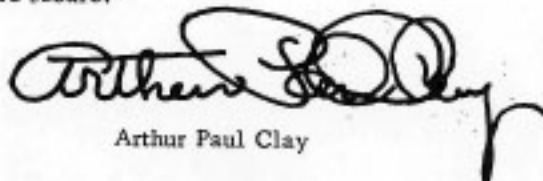
The session 1963-64 marks the first issue of a yearbook put out by

work worthwhile and our future secure.



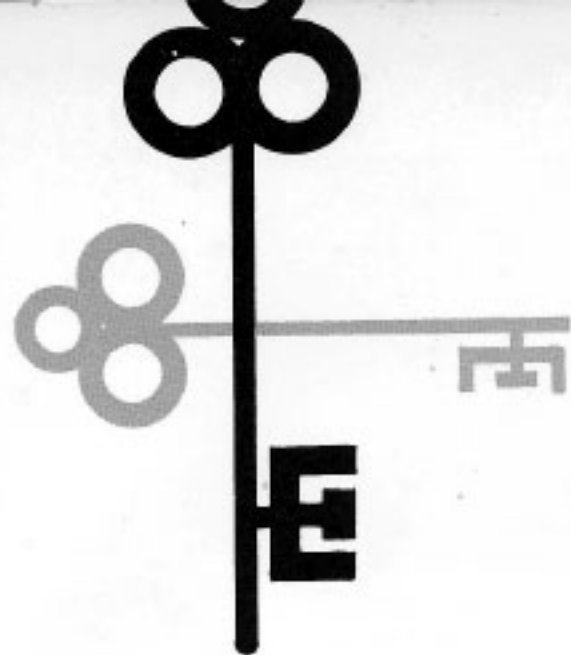
