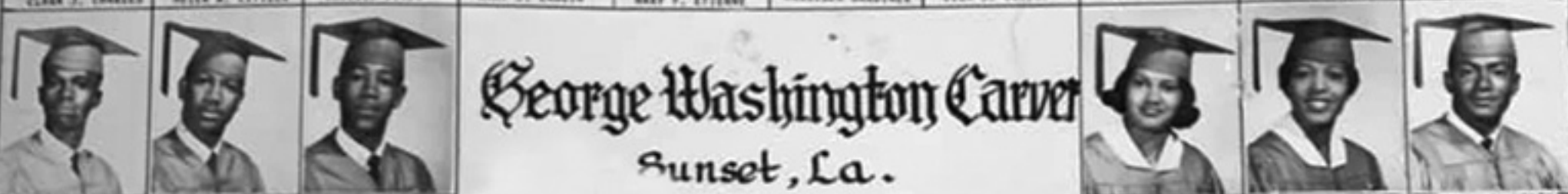
top ranking senior, with Patricia Belson in second place; Juanita Henry and Janella Eaglin tied for third place honors, according to Principal Edward Ray.



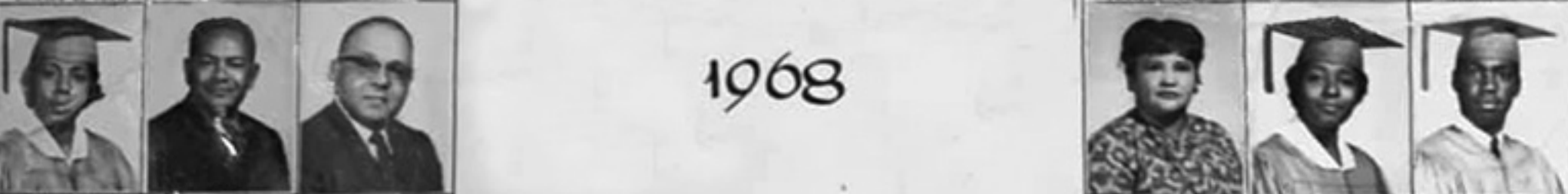
