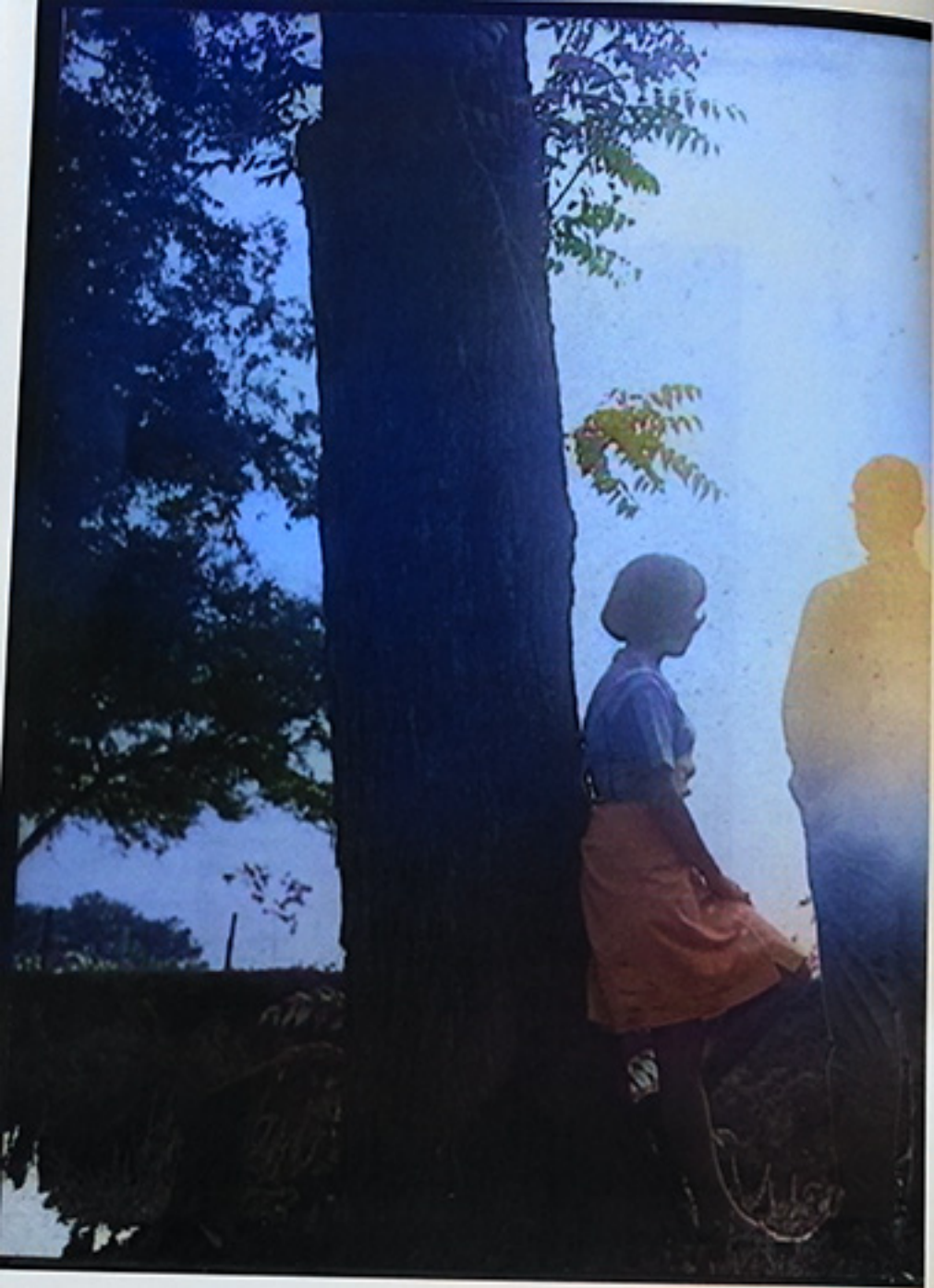

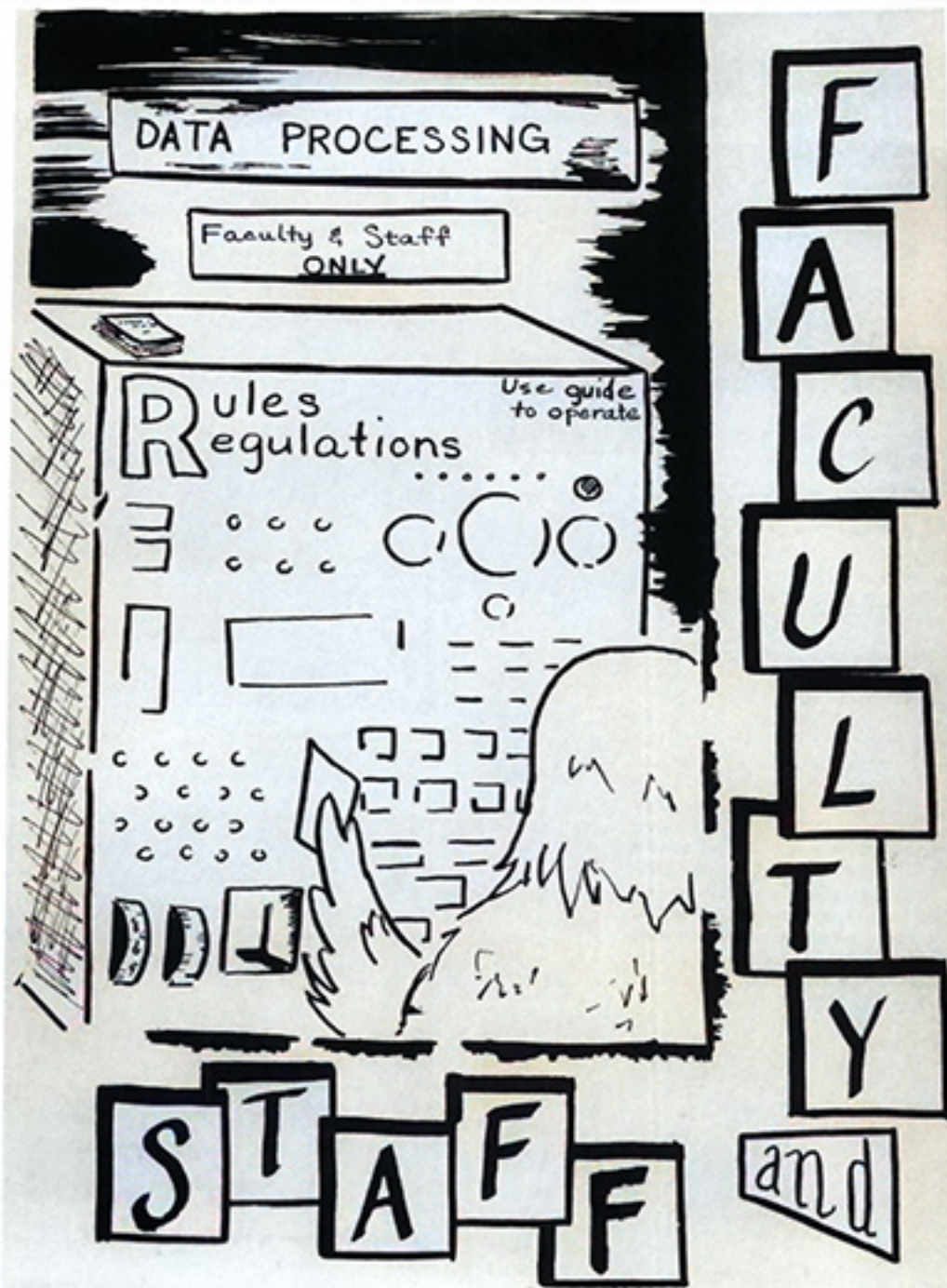

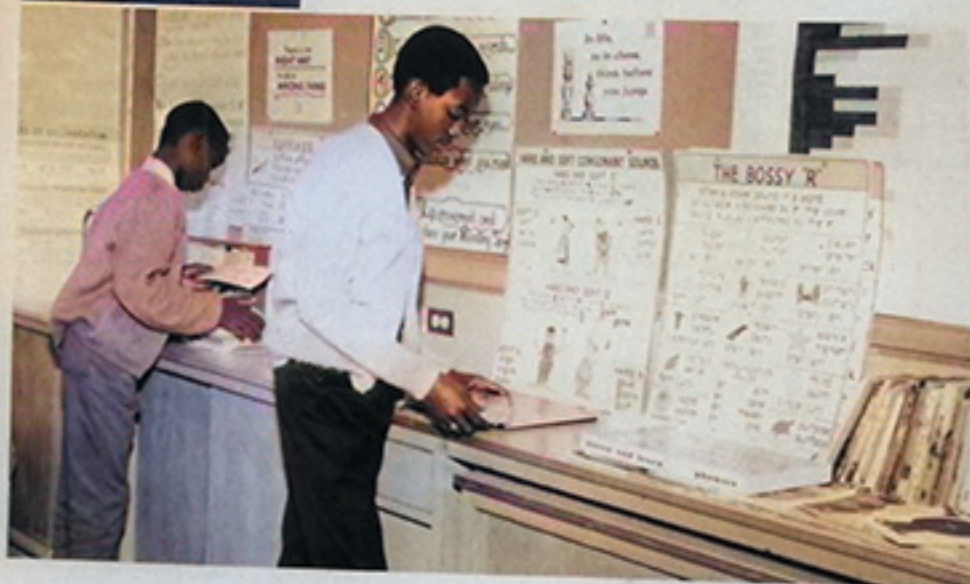

The reading services at Union High School are based on the fundamental principles of a developmental program of instruction. These services are coordinated by a full-time reading specialist from the central office curriculum and instruction staff, who has the following responsibility:

1. To work with teachers in their respective classes on diagnosis, placement, grouping and methods and materials of instruction.
2. To do special work with teachers in professional study, through meetings, conferences and sharing methods and materials.
3. To do experimental teaching with small groups of underachievers, at his discretion, in order to point up workable methods and procedure to recommend to teachers for use in their classrooms.
