


















Elgy Sam Track & Field



Elgy Sam is a 1964 graduate of Plaisance High School. He was an outstanding track star on both high school and college levels. He held the state record in 120 high hurdles—14.2 and the state record in 180 low hurdles—18.9.

He was the 1st athlete in Louisiana to run 120 yard high hurdles in less than 14 seconds (13.8).

On the college level in the 400 meter hurdles, he never lost a race making him an All American in college which means he had the 2nd fastest time in the world (49.9).

In 1967, prior to the Olympics, he was injured in running the 4-1 relay.


