Initiative will put me on my own,

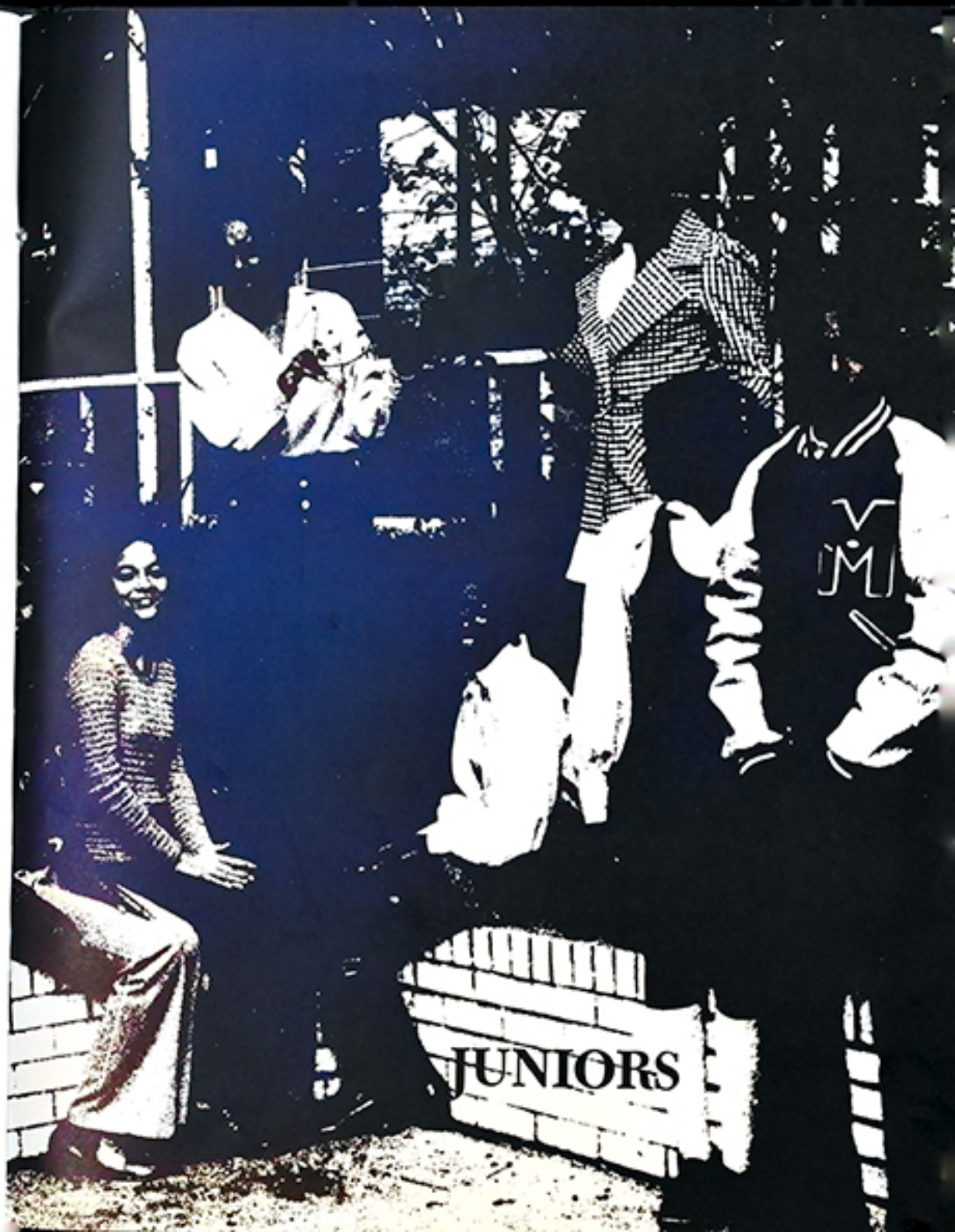
and with initiative I may sometimes stand alone.

It was the staff's hope that the preceding pages have presented McKinley as it was during the year 1973. We want you to get from these few pages a glimpse of what goes on at McKinley every school day. Regrettably we can only give a glimpse of the school life, for that which fully represents McKinley for the year is carried in the minds of the 1,065 students who trampled its halls during this time.

This annual was the first in several years to come from our school. We tried to make it better. There was so much we wanted to include but couldn't. Many things were done to bring about the publishing of this book that will never be known to those except the staff.

The hardest part in producing this book, to me, has been the obtaining of persons sincerely interested in producing a good book to work on it. Fortunately I did.

There were many times, when I felt that I should not see to the book being published. But an inner force kept pushing me on.
