


EDITOR - Hense Parson

# A A MANAS

The Tensas Rosenwald High School Girls under the leadership of Coach Gladys Hamlin Edwards won the "AAA" LIALO State Title with case at Grambling College, February 26, 1966.

The Tensas Girls with their fast moving game were in command all of the way.

In the first game they whipped J. S. Clark of Opelousas 65-44. In the second game they downed Webster of Minden 52-28, and in the finals they dropped DeSoto Mansfield 43-23. This was a sweet revenge because it was DeSoto who stood between them and the state title last year.

It looked as if DeSoto had a chance until the fourth quarter when the Tensasans began to really turn on the steam as they went into over drive with the fast breaks and the driving lay-ups, and out scored DeSoto in that quarter 15-2.

Including tournaments the Lassies of Tensas played 38 ball games, winning 34 and losing 4. No team beat them and got away without falling to them later. They won their district with 13 wins and one lost. The team second a total of 2,005 points while allowing their opponents only 1,210. 
